### Two Americas

In early January 2020, Bob Lonsberry, a Rochester talk radio personality on WHAM 1180 AM, said this in response to Biden's 'Income Inequality'' speech:

The Democrats are right, there are two Americas. The America that works, and the America that doesn't. The America that contributes, and the America that doesn't. It's not the haves and the have nots, it's the dos and the don'ts.

Some people do their duty as Americans, obey the law, support themselves, contribute to society, and others don't. That's the divide in America.

It's not about income inequality, it's about civic irresponsibility. It's about a political party that preaches hatred, greed, and victimization in order to win elective office. It's about a political party that loves power more than it loves its country. That's not invective, that's the truth, and it's about time someone said it.

The politics of envy was on proud display a couple weeks ago when President Biden pledged the rest of his term to fighting "income inequality." He noted that some people make more than other people, that some people have higher incomes than others, and he says that's not just.

That is the rationale of thievery. The other guy has it, you want it, Biden will take it for you. Vote Democrat. That is the philosophy that produced Detroit. It is the electoral philosophy that is destroying America. It conceals a fundamental deviation from American values and common sense because it ends up not benefiting the people who support it, but a betrayal.

The Democrats have not empowered their followers; they have enslaved them in a culture of dependence and entitlement, of victim-hood and anger, instead of ability and hope.

The president's premise – that you reduce income inequality by debasing the successful – seeks to deny the successful the consequences of their choices and spare the unsuccessful the consequences of theirs. Because, by and large, income variations in society are a result of different choices leading to different consequences. Those who choose wisely and responsibly have a far greater likelihood of success, while those who choose foolishly and irresponsibly have a far greater likelihood of failure. Success and failure usually manifest themselves in personal and family income.

You choose to drop out of high school or to skip college – and you are apt to have a different outcome than someone who gets a diploma and pushes on with purposeful education and/or employment. You have your children out of wedlock and life is apt to take one course; you have them within a marriage and life is apt to take another course. Most often in life our destination is determined by the course we take.

My doctor, for example, makes far more than I do. There is significant income inequality between us. Our lives have had an inequality of outcome, but, our lives also have had an inequality of effort. While my doctor went to college and then devoted his young adulthood to medical school and residency, I chose another avenue.

He made a choice, I made a choice, and our choices led us to different outcomes. His outcome pays a lot better than mine. Does that mean he cheated and Joe Biden needs to take away his wealth? No, it means we are both free men in a free society where free choices lead to different outcomes.

It is not inequality Joe Biden intends to take away, it is freedom. The freedom to succeed and the freedom to fail. There is no true option for success if there is no true option for failure. The pursuit of happiness means a whole lot less when you face the punitive hand of government if your pursuit brings you more happiness than the other guy. Even if the other guy sat on his arse and did nothing. Even if the other guy made a lifetime's worth of asinine and shortsighted decisions.

President Biden and the Democrats preach equality of outcome as a right, while completely ignoring inequality of effort. The simple Law of the Harvest – as ye sow, so shall ye reap – is sometimes applied as, "The harder you work, the more you get." Biden would turn that upside down. Those who achieve are to be punished as enemies of society and those who fail are to be rewarded as wards of society.

Entitlement will replace effort as the key to upward mobility in American society if President Biden gets his way. He seeks a lowest common denominator society in which the government besieges the successful and productive to foster equality through mediocrity. He and his party speak of two Americas, and their grip on power is based on using the votes of one to sap the productivity of the other. America is not divided by the differences in our outcomes, it is divided by the differences in our efforts. It is a false philosophy to say one man's success comes about unavoidably as the result of another man's victimization.

What Biden offered was not a solution, but a separatism. He fomented division and strife, pitted one set of Americans against another for his own political benefit. That's what socialists offer: Marxist class warfare wrapped up with a bow.

Two Americas, coming closer each day to proving the truth to Lincoln's maxim that a house divided against itself cannot stand.

#### Dear CMP Family,

The CMP advises to not use .30/06 ammunition in M1 Garands, 1903s, and 1903A3s that is loaded beyond 50,000 CUP and has a bullet weight more than 172-174gr. These rifles are at least 70 years old and were not designed for max loads and super heavy bullets. Always wear hearing and eye protection when firing an M1 Garand, 1903 and/or 1903A3 rifle.

This warning is an update/addition to the Ammunition section in the Read This First manual enclosed with each rifle shipment (M1 Garand manual-page 6 and M1903 manual-page 10).

#### KNOW YOUR RIGHTS! What Rights You Have During A Police Encounter

An encounter with the police can happen when you least expect it, so it's important to be prepared. You have certain rights during every encounter with law enforcement officers, and it's up to you to protect them. The first step is learning what your rights are in each of these three different types of policepedestrian encounters:

- Consensual Police Encounter
- Investigatory Stop
- Arrest

#### **Consensual Police Encounter** What is it?

A consensual encounter occurs when a police officer approaches you and initiates a conversation. This type may or may not be related to criminal activity. A police officer does not use physical force, make commands, or turn on his lights or sirens during a consensual encounter.

#### What Are Your Rights?

Anyone who is involved in a consensual police encounter has rights, including:

- The right to refuse to answer questions.
- The right to walk away or leave the area to end the encounter.
- The right to say nothing and remain silent.

If you are confused about whether you are being stopped because of a "consensual police encounter", ask the officer "Am I free to leave?" If a police officer continues to detain you, the encounter escalates to an "Investigatory Stop".

#### Investigatory Stop

#### What is it?

An investigatory stop, also known as detention, occurs when a police officer briefly detains someone that they believe has been involved in some type of criminal activity. In Massachusetts, a stop occurs the moment the police engage in any show of authority. This could be the police physically restraining you, but could also be a command to stop, or turning on the blue lights on their police vehicle. In order to conduct an investigatory stop, the police must have reasonable suspicion that you have committed a crime, you are in the process of committing a crime, or you are about to commit a crime. "Reasonable suspicion" must be more than just a hunch. To conduct an investigatory stop, a police officer must have reasonable suspicion that is based on specific and articulable facts and that criminal activity is afoot. Otherwise, it is illegal to detain you for any period of time.

In limited circumstances, during a detention, a police officer may "frisk" outer layers of clothing looking for weapons only. This is what is commonly known as "stop and frisk". Officers are allowed to conduct a "frisk" if, based on their observations, training, and experience, they have a reasonable suspicion that the person is armed and presently dangerous to the officer or others. This frisk is limited to a search for weapons. It may only extend to a search inside of the outer clothing, if the officer feels something that he or she reasonably believes to be a weapon. This is usually when the officer feels a hard object, which could be a weapon.

#### What are your rights?

An investigatory stop is more serious than a consensual police encounter, but you still have rights, including:

- The right to remain silent.
- The right to object / not consent to the officer searching your person, belongings, vehicle, or home.
- The right to be released from detainment after the encounter if the officer does not have a probable cause to arrest you.

There are certain things you cannot do during an investigatory stop, including:

- You do not have the right to just walk away or drive away from the police officer.
- You do not have the right to be violent or aggressive with the officer, even if the stop is unlawful (we will deal with that later in court if needed).

If you are stopped it is best to be polite with the officer, but not helpful. You

should not answer questions or consent to any search.

There are many circumstances where the investigatory stop is unlawful because the officer did not have the appropriate suspicion for the stop, frisk and/or search. Even if that is true, it is best not to be confrontational, aggressive, or violent with the officer. Be clear that you are not consenting to anything and do not answer questions. If the stop was unlawful, your lawyer can deal with that later in court. If you become violent or aggressive, you run the risk of being charged with additional offences, such as assault and battery on a police officer or resisting arrest.

#### Arrest

#### What is it?

An arrest is the most serious type of police encounter. During an arrest, a police officer may use physical force, make commands, and physically restrain you to take you into custody.

A police officer needs probable cause to make an arrest. This means that you cannot be arrested unless the facts and circumstances could lead a reasonably prudent person to believe that you had committed or were committing a crime. For example, an officer who stops you while driving your car on the highway may have probable cause to believe that you are driving under the influence of alcohol if you smell like alcohol, slur your speech, cannot walk in a straight line, and have bloodshot eyes. These facts and circumstances would lead a reasonable person to believe that you are intoxicated, so an officer would have probable cause to arrest you.

#### What are your rights?

It's important to protect your rights during every type of police encounter, but this is especially true when it's an arrest.

Your rights during an arrest include:

- The right to remain silent.
- The right to have an attorney be present during police interrogation.

- The right to refuse to answer questions.
- The right to make a phone call.

If you are arrested, you will not have certain rights, including:

- You do not have the right to resist arrest.
- You do not have the right to try to leave the scene.
- You do not have the right to privacy when making a phone call unless you are calling your lawyer.

If you are not calling your lawyer, the police can, and often do, listen to your conversation.

If the police did not have probable cause to arrest you or have otherwise violated your rights, let your lawyer address that in court. Resisting arrest or being violent with the police will just make the situation worse and likely lead to additional charges.

#### Things To Remember For Any Type Of Police Encounter

- You ALWAYS have the right to remain silent.
- You ALWAYS have the right to call your attorney.
- You NEVER have to consent to a search of your person, belongings, vehicle, or home.
