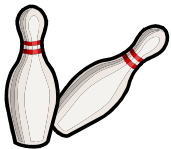

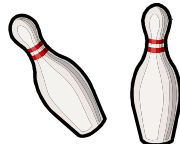

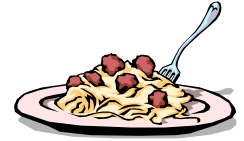

William J Moisan Jr

Country Pond Fish & Game Club lost one of its outstanding members, Bill Moisan, on Friday April 9. Bill was a life member of our club. His tireless efforts to benefit our organization were truly inspiring. As a returning veteran of World War II, Bill was instrumental in the resurrection of Country Pond Fish & Game from the pit of neglect that many organizations suffered during the war. He spent huge amounts of his time and talent maintaining the club and making major improvements that we all benefit from to this day.

In his life, Bill served with the United States Army 100th Division in Europe. He was a Prisoner of War and suffered wounds in the Battle of the Bulge. Bill was awarded the Silver Star, Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Combat Infantry Badge, and battle ribbons with two stars. He played professional baseball from 1946 through 1955, including stints with the Chicago Cubs in 1953 and 1954. Bill was a lifetime member of the Association of Professional Baseball Players, Major League Baseball Player Alumni, and American Legion Post 34 of Plaistow, NH.

All of us who knew Bill are better people because of his friendship and genuine concern for people. We will miss him.

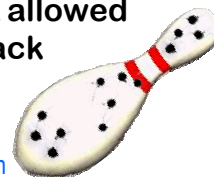
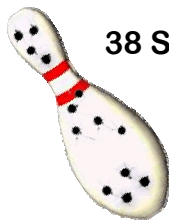

- All Transfers: \$10

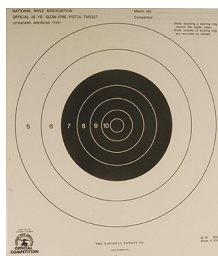

A form for this purpose is available at the club. If this data is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and a \$10.00 charge will be assessed to the Member.

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, for any firearms orders or transactions.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.
