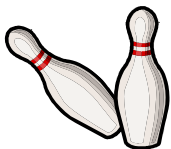

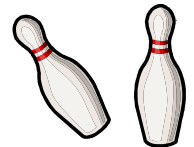

CPF&G Club FFL Fees & Rules

- Firearms up to \$600: \$10
- Firearms \$601 & up: \$15
- Ammo & Accessories: 5%
- All Transfers: \$10

Members who order guns themselves, to be delivered to the Club, must require the sender to include an invoice or other form describing the firearms' make, model, caliber, serial number, and name of sender. A form for this purpose is available at the club. If this data is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and a \$10.00 charge will be assessed to the Member.

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, for any firearms orders or transactions.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.

Proposed Club Bylaw Change

This newsletter article constitutes notice required in accordance with Article X of the current Club Bylaws. This proposed change will be voted on at the 16 September General Meeting.

The Board of Directors recommends the following change to the Club Bylaws.

To add:

7.1.1 Any Regular or Family Member, who has contributed to the Club a minimum of ten documented hours in any calendar year, shall receive, if applied for, a 20% reduction in their membership dues for the following year.

7.1.2 Members wishing to apply for the discount cited in Section 7.1.1 must maintain their own CPF&G Club Member Work Log. Hours recorded in this Log must be countersigned by a Club Officer, Director, or Committee or Event Chair. This Log form must be submitted with the member's yearly renewal form in order to obtain the discount. Log forms will be available on the Club website and at the Club.

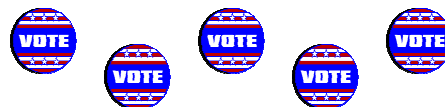
