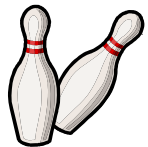

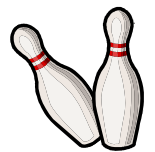

CPF&G Club FFL Fees & Rules

- Firearms up to \$600: \$10
- Firearms \$601 & up: \$15
- Ammo & Accessories: 5%
- All Transfers: \$10

Members who order guns themselves, to be delivered to the Club, must require the sender to include an invoice or other form describing the firearms' make, model, caliber, serial number, and name of sender. A form for this purpose is available at the club. If this data is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and a \$10.00 charge will be assessed to the Member.

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, for any firearms orders or transactions.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.

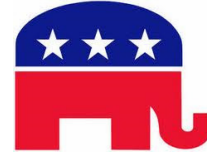

NH Politics & Legislation

With the new year a new legislative session begins. The following is a partial list of some proposed legislation that is being scrutinized by Gun Owners of New Hampshire.

- 2011-H-0009-R
relative to state authority over firearms and ammunition
- 2011-H-0012-R
relative to carrying firearms
- 2011-H-0030-R
permitting a person to petition the superior court for any action pertaining to a pistol or revolver license
- 2011-H-0031-R
relative to the state's authority to prohibit or regulate firearms, firearms components, ammunition, or firearms supplies
- 2011-H-0039-R
relative to physical force in defense of a person
- 2011-H-0078-R
relative to lawful commerce in firearms, including manufacture and sale in New Hampshire
- 2011-H-0375-R
making changes to the pupil safety and violence prevention act
- 2011-H-0400-R
relative to the taking of private property during a state of emergency
- 2011-H-0427-R
relative to immunity for school personnel using necessary force to protect pupils
- 2011-H-0440-R
inserting an exception to the criminal threatening statute
- 2011-H-0446-R
relative to the right to brandish a firearm in defense of one's property
- 2011-S-0453-R
relative to the brandishing of a firearm (Senate)
- 2011-H-0495-R
relative to the return of personal property by law enforcement agencies
- 2011-H-0540-R
making various changes to the fish and game laws

- 2011-H-0567-R
requiring law enforcement agencies to take proper care of firearms seized pursuant to a domestic violence order for relief
- 2011-H-0642-R
instituting an apprentice hunting license
- 2011-H-0643-R
relative to the certificates of completion of a basic hunter education program or bow hunter education program
- 2011-H-0655-R
relative to the right to possess a firearm in one's personal motor vehicle
- 2011-H-0709-R
relative to the right to carry a firearm, openly or concealed, without a license
- 2011-S-0921-R
repealing the prohibition on the unauthorized use of firearms and firecrackers in the compact part of a town (Senate)

It is going to be a very busy legislative season this year. Some of the proposed legislation may have merit with a little tweaking here and there. The wording of the complete text of the bills is where we really have to be vigilant. The Gun Owners of New Hampshire organization is dedicated to this purpose. The Legislative (Review) Committee of GONH has kicked into high gear, with the help of Attorney Penny Dean, to review any and all legislation that may be a help or a hindrance to New Hampshire gun owners.

There are also some new regulations in effect starting January 1, 2011 for NH fishermen. Some new definitions have been put in the rules and regulations for anglers. Artificial bait, bait, artificial flies, fly fishing, trolling, and tandem flies all have some new definitions.
