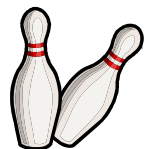

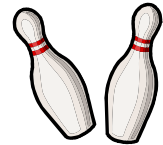

Why is the Indoor Range "Always Closed" ?

We've heard some people grouching that the ranges - especially the Indoor Range - are "always closed".

Well, they're not - not all the time, not half the time, not even 15% of the time.

It's true that a lot of activities have been scheduled during the winter months

that affect the Indoor Range, and that's nothing new. The Indoor Archery and Pistol Leagues have been going on for many years, Bowling Pin Shoots for several years, and the annual Chowder Fest, Chili Cookoff, and Game Dinners are also long standing Club traditions.

All of these activities serve a significant percentage of Club Members, and they're not going to go away. Neither are any of the well established activities and events that affect other ranges.

The chart to the left shows that for the vast majority of the time, all of the ranges are wide open - never less than 85% for any range, and never less than 88% for the Indoor Range.

Apart from rare emergency situations, Range Closures are published well in advance - usually at least 45 days - and there's no excuse for not being aware of them. The best ways to keep up to date are by checking the Club website, the monthly Calendar, and the Newsletter. If you do that, you'll stay well informed as to the best times to enjoy shooting at CPF&G.

Keep in mind that shooting on a Closed Range is a serious safety violation, and potentially dangerous. Don't do it.

The 2010-2011 .22 Plate Shoot season has ended. This season, we had to cancel the February match due to excessive snow, but the remaining matches went off without a hitch, averaging 30 shooters per month. April was our most popular match, with 33 shooters participating.

We added a new wrinkle to this year's matches - a Tag Team Shoot. Most everyone seemed to really enjoy this added event, where 5-shooter teams have to dispatch 40 targets in the shortest time, with each shooter on a team starting out with only five rounds each in their magazines.

We're looking forward to next season, which starts in November 2011. These matches have gotten to be so popular that the plan at that time is to start shooting one match every month, year 'round, instead of just during the winter. The new 22 Plates Chairman, Bob Lawliss, will be taking care of that. (Thanks, Bob.) At least the summer matches won't have to contend with snow so deep that the target racks sink out of sight. (Makes 'em a little hard to hit.)

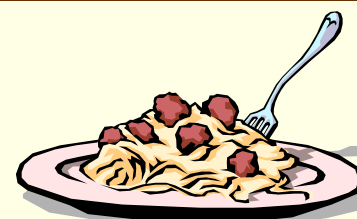

NH Politics & Legislation

HB 210-FN: This bill allows a person who is in any place where he or she has a right to be or reasonably believed he or she had a right to be to use deadly force to protect oneself. Passed by the House on 15 March and went to Senate Judiciary Committee, where it has been since 23 March. A hearing was held on 7 April in the Legislative Office Building. There has been neither a majority nor minority report on this legislation. Similar legislation has been vetoed by Governor Lynch in the past.

HB378: Inserting an exception to the criminal threatening statute: that a person who is on his or her own property and who responds to a trespasser who refuses to leave, and displays a firearm or other means of self-defense with intent to warn away the person making the threat, shall not have committed criminal threatening. This bill passed the House with an adopted amendment on 15 March and is now in the Senate Judiciary Committee. A hearing was scheduled for 7 April. Once again neither a majority nor minority report has been issued by the committee.

SB88: Relative to physical force in defense on a person and relative to the brandishing of a firearm or other means of self-defense. This bill:

- 1) Removes a person's duty to retreat from an encounter involving deadly force.
- 2) Provides that a person is not justified in using deadly force on another to defend himself, herself, or a third person from the use of deadly force that he or she provoked.
- 3) Provides that, except as otherwise prohibited by statute, a person who is anywhere he or she has a right to be and who displays or brandishes a firearm or other means of self-defense to warn off a threat shall not be guilty of criminal threatening. This bill passed/adopted with amendment by the Senate on 30 March. It is now in the House Criminal Justice Committee and is due out of committee on 26 May. A public hearing was held on 12 April. The following are excerpts from an article in the Union Leader of 13 April about the hearing. "The bill would allow people to use deadly force in self-defense anywhere they have a right to be." "However, opponents including the state attorney general said NH has very strong self-defense laws that carefully balance the sanctity of life against the right to protect oneself." "Concord Attorney Penny Dean disagreed saying the state's self-defense laws are weak, noting there have been many bills over the years to fix the problems." "Attorney Dean and Ralph Demicco of Gun Owners of NH agreed the intent and spirit of SB88 is good, but the bill needs major revisions." The committee did not make an immediate recommendation on the bill.

Update: **HB 330:** introduced by Representative Jennifer Coffey (R-Merrimack 6), is focused on allowing any person who can legally carry a firearm to possess a firearm openly or concealed without obtaining a license. The current license system would remain in place for those individuals who wish

to carry concealed in states that recognize New Hampshire licenses. However, important changes are still needed. The NRA, along with its state affiliate – Gun Owners of New Hampshire (GO-NH) – is advocating an omnibus amendment to clarify certain provisions in HB 330. In addition, the NRA and GO-NH are supporting changes which would keep the existing law in place for individuals 18 years of age or younger to possess a firearm for hunting under certain conditions.

Personal Commentary:

Once again the fact that politicians fear law-abiding citizens who choose to arm themselves for self-defense is rather obvious in my opinion. It is curious that most rank and file police officers don't have a problem with law-abiding citizens being armed but the politically motivated chiefs of police agree with the politicians who don't trust us. The same old stale arguments of "wild west" mentality on our streets prevail. As stated in last months Politics and Legislation report we have some legislators who are trying to solidify our firearms rights but they are being influenced by the political slight of hand that is prevalent in our state house and state houses across the country. Being "Ever Vigilant" is as important today as it was during the terms of other anti-gun administrations both on the state and federal levels.
