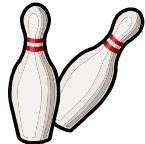

New Hampshire Politics & Legislation



Win!

Thanks to a strong response from GO-NH members and leadership, in cooperation with other pro-firearms rights groups here in NH, our representatives in Concord took a bold step and rebuked the Governor, sending a strong message to every part of NH government: We want our rights preserved and strengthened, including rights that elitist bureaucrats would rather deny us, like self-defense.

AN ACT relative to physical force in defense of a person, relative to producing or displaying a firearm or other means of self-defense, and relative to eliminating minimum sentencing and adding civil immunity for certain firearm use. This bill:

I. Allows a person who is anywhere he or she has a right to be to use deadly force to protect oneself or a third person.

II. Inserts a civil immunity provision for the use of force against a perpetrator in certain circumstances.

III. Deletes the minimum mandatory sentencing requirement for felony convictions which include the possession, use, or attempted use of a firearm.

IV. Amends the definition of "non-deadly force" to include the act of producing or displaying a weapon.

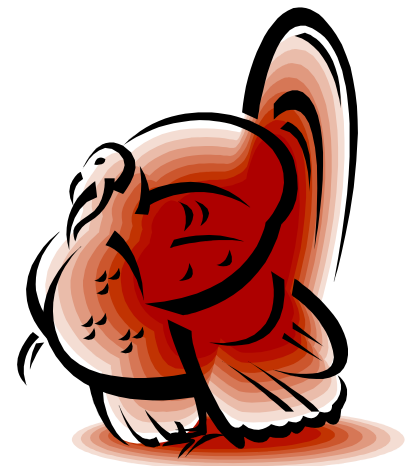

Membership Renewals

Membership renewals for 2012 are due on or before 31 December 2011. On-time renewal is your responsibility; we do not send out renewal bills.

2012 dues are the same as last year: \$125 for a Regular Membership and \$187.50 for a Family Membership.

Renewal Forms can be found on the Club website, in the Clubhouse main hall, the downstairs hall, and by the sign in log book in the indoor range. Be sure to fill out the form completely and sign it, as we use this to update your information. For a Family Membership, you must complete and sign a separate form with each person's information and signature. Life, Permanent, and Honorary members must also fill out a renewal form each year to ensure their

correct information is on file. Military Members must apply each year for their Military Membership discount. A copy of your military ID with expiration date is required. Failure to completely fill out and sign forms may cause a delay in issuing new membership cards.

Failure to submit a Renewal form by 31 December will terminate your membership on that date.

Work Credit hours are available to offset Club dues. It's up to you to keep track of your hours worked and get your credit hour form signed by the appropriate event coordinator. A minimum of 10 hours worked on Club projects in a calendar year could earn you a 20% discount on the next year's dues.
