- Firearms up to \$600: \$10
- Firearms \$601 & up: \$15
- Ammo & Accessories: 5%
- All Transfers: \$10

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, and evenings by appointment, for any firearms orders or transactions.

Club Members may also order guns themselves, to be delivered to the Club, but must have the sender include a copy of the Club's Firearms Order Form. This form is available on the "Members Only" page of the Club website and at the Club. If this form is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and return shipping plus a \$10.00 service charge will be assessed to the Member.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.

If you would like to volunteer to take over this event, beginning in 2012, please contact Sharon before this year's party, so she can show you what the job entails.

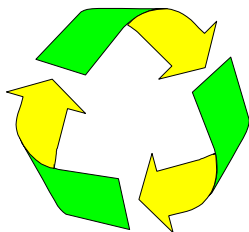

## Metals Recycling

As some of you know, Country Pond Fish & Game Club recycles lead and brass. The Club gets a nice check every month or two from this program.



When cleaning up after shooting, both on the indoor and outdoor ranges, please take the time to dispose of your unwanted brass in the appropriate containers, and not in the trash barrels. Indoors, it's the big yellow box behind Lane #5. On the Outdoor Range, they're those white converted propane tanks on the rear benches. It will be appreciated.

## Membership Renewals

Membership renewals for 2012 are due on or before 31 December 2011. On-time renewal is your responsibility; we do not send out renewal bills.

2012 dues are the same as last year: \$125 for a Regular Membership and \$187.50 for a Family Membership.

Renewal Forms can be found on the Club website, in the Clubhouse main hall, the downstairs hall, and by the sign in log book in the indoor range. Be sure to fill out the form completely and sign it, as we use this to update your information. For a Family Membership, you must complete and sign a separate form with each person's information and signature. **LIFE, PERMANENT, and HONORARY members must also fill out a renewal form each year to**

ensure their correct information is on file. Military Members must apply each year for their Military Membership discount. A copy of your military ID with expiration date is required. Failure to completely fill out and sign forms may cause a delay in issuing new membership cards.

**Failure to submit a Renewal form by 31 December will terminate your membership on that date.**

Work Credit hours are available to offset Club dues. It's up to you to keep track of your hours and get your credit hour form signed by the appropriate event coordinator. A minimum of 10 hours worked on Club projects in a calendar year could earn you a 20% discount on the next year's dues.
