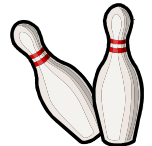

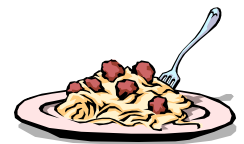

## .22 Rimfire Duds

Hi fellow Members. I'm Glenn Steele, the one who empties the dud boxes at the Club. I separate the components and dispose of them safely.

Lately I've seen a lot of .22 rimfire rounds in the dud boxes. I noticed that several were from the same manufacturer, so when I broke them down I paid close attention to the powder. Mixed in with the powder was the green primer from inside the shell. This was from about 15 or 20 rounds. That's a lot of duds in a box of ammo.

I sent off an email to the manufacturer, that they may be having problems with their primer mix. They were pleased to get my email, (sounds crazy, but I believe them), but they said there was nothing they could do without the lot number and remainder of rounds to test. That makes total sense to me. If you have bad ammo, email the company to see how they want to work sending the ammo back to them. You paid good money for that ammo, why should you have to throw it away! I know it's aggravating to go through the hassle of sending something back to the manufacturer, but who knows, they may send you back several boxes in exchange. No matter what, you gave feedback to a manufacturer that their ammo is not good. They do not like that. They lose money.

One more thing I found. Don't get too up tight about this, but you need to clean your firearms. I see a lot of dented cases. I see a lot of cut, sliced, and crushed in bullet tips. This comes from powder residue buildup and lack of lubrication. Especially with 22 semi autos, you have to keep the slide mechanism clean and lubed. Try it, you'll like it.

You're doing great using the dud boxes. Be safe at the range.

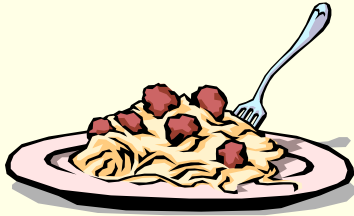
