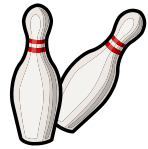

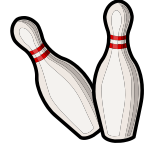

### Proposed Club Bylaw Change

### LEGAL NOTICE

The Country Pond Fish & Game Club Bylaws may only be modified by the General Membership. At the next monthly Members meeting, to be held on 21 September, the following change to Bylaw 3.8 will be voted on. (Modifications are shown in RED)

#### 3.8 Life Member

- a. Any member in good standing may apply for an individual Life Membership. Family Members in good standing may apply for Family Life Membership.
- b. A maximum of one hundred (100) Life Memberships will be available. For the purpose of this rule, a Family Membership shall count as two Life Memberships.
- c. Life memberships will be granted on a first come, first served, basis.
- d. The cost for Life Membership shall be set as follows:

(1) Individual Life Membership if the member is under 40 years of age: 12.5 times the existing Regular Membership cost, **rounded up to the nearest \$10.**

(2) Individual Life Membership if the member is 40 years of age or over: 10 times the existing Regular Membership cost, **rounded up to the nearest \$10.**

(3) Family Life Membership if the average of the Members' ages is under 40: 12.5 times the existing Family Membership cost, **rounded up to the nearest \$10.**

(4) Family Life Membership if the average of the Members' ages is 40 or over: 10 times the existing Family Membership cost, **rounded up to the nearest \$10.**

This is only intended to simplify bookkeeping efforts. \$2,350 is easier to deal with than \$2,343.75.
