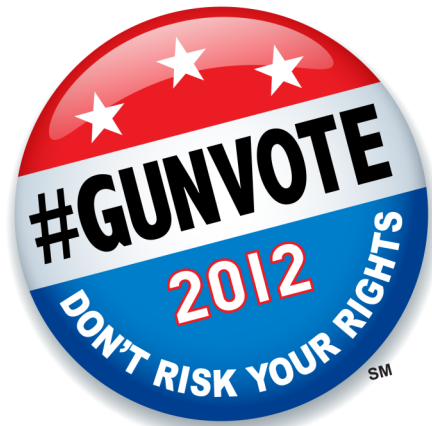
This article originally appeared in the August 2000 issue of "The Blue Press", the catalog of Dillon Precision Products, Inc. It was relevant then, and it's certainly relevant now. 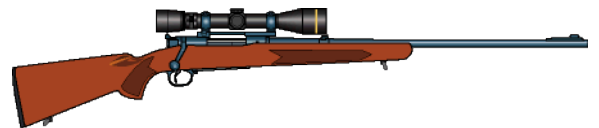

Wading Through the Medicaid Swamp

Some of our Club Members are in their golden years and may need Medicaid in the future, to cover the costs of long term nursing home care. My wife, Anne Marie, suffered a stroke back in March, 2010, and my family had a very long learning curve discovering exactly what the government wanted to process our Medicaid claim.

Below is a list of documents and references to have on hand that could hopefully help others shorten the process.

Birth Certificate
 Marriage Certificate
 Spouse's Death Certificate
 Auto Title & Registration
 Social Security Card
 Medicare Card
 Other health insurance cards
 Health insurance premium statement
 Social Security statement for current year
 Pension statement
 Bank statements for the last five years
 Explanation of any deposits and withdrawals of \$1,000.00 or more (for both open & closed accounts)
 Deeds of property owned in the past five years
 Mortgage statement
 Heating bill
 Statement of land rent for mobile home
 Statement for any accounts closed in the last five years
 Date of admission to nursing home
 Date of admission to hospital, prior to nursing home
 Tax bill for any new real estate owned
 IRA statements
 Monthly prescription expenses
 Monthly budget – all expenses – keep some receipts!
 Life insurance policies
 Annuity policies
 Power of attorney
 Prepaid funeral contract
 Burial plot deed
 Homeowner insurance statement
 Picture ID, with Social Security number, date & place of birth

Be sure to submit only copies and keep the originals. Some documents have information on both sides, so be sure to copy the back side as well.



Note that in order to qualify for Medicaid benefits the applicant must have no more than \$2,500 in assets (\$2,000 if applying to Mass Health). If it is one penny over, the application will be denied.

Any gifts made by the applicant within five years prior to applying for Medicaid could cause the application to be disqualified. Inform your attorney of any such gifts.

I can't emphasize enough how important it is to have a good health care attorney to guide you through the process.

NH Department of Public Safety Firearms Qualifications

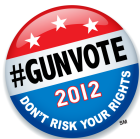
*Have you ever wondered what NH cops need to do to qualify with their duty firearms?
Here's the Qualification Procedure they have to go through.*

SECTION	DISTANCE	ROUNDS	FORMAT	TIME
A	3 yds	4	2 Sets of 2 rds from Holster, Strong Hand	3 sec/set
B	5 yds	6	3 rds 15 Degree Cant, Right Hand 3 rds 15 Degree Cant, Left Hand	7 sec
C	7 yds	6	One Set of 6 rds, Cover Down Holster	8 sec
D	10 yds	6	One Set of 6 rds, Cover Down Holster	10 sec
E	15 yds	8	2 Right Side Tilt Out, 2 Right Side Kneeling, reload, 2 Left Side Tilt Out, 2 Left Side Kneeling (all strong hand)	25 sec
F	25 yds	6	Stand 5 ft behind cover, upon command move to kneeling position behind cover (strong side), draw weapon, fire 2 rds. Repeat twice	8 sec/set



This course of fire must be fired twice consecutively, passing both times.
36 Rounds Total - Q Target - 27 contacts for 75% Pass/Fail.

Note: Reloading - given numerous weapons, magazine capacity, and calibers - will be done upon need by the candidate, except for Section E.

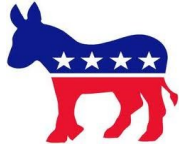

be trusted to run the United States of America.

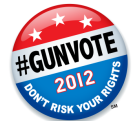
