

### The Bill of No Rights

## Membership Renewals

Membership renewals for 2013 are due on or before 31 December 2012.

On-time renewal is your responsibility; we do not send out renewal bills.

Dues have been increased this year: \$175 for a Regular Membership and \$262.50 for a Family Membership.

Renewal Forms can be found in this newsletter, on the Club website, in the Clubhouse main hall, the downstairs hall, and by the sign in log book in the indoor range. Be sure to fill out the form completely and sign it, as we use this to update your information. For a Family Membership, you must complete and sign a separate form with each person's information and signature. LIFE, PERMANENT, and HONORARY members must also fill out a renewal form each year to ensure their correct information is on file. Military Members must apply each year for their Military Membership discount. A copy of your military ID with expiration date is required. Failure to completely fill out and sign forms may cause a delay in issuing new membership cards.

Failure to submit a Renewal form by 31 December will terminate your membership on that date.

Work Credit hours are available to offset Club dues. It's up to you to keep track of your hours and get your credit hour form signed by the appropriate event coordinator. A minimum of 10 hours worked on Club projects in a calendar year could earn you a 20% discount on the next year's dues.

# ANNUAL MEETING ~ 20 DECEMBER ~

### **Dillon Loading Presses**

Many handloaders use Dillon equipment. Here are a few guidelines for keeping your gear running smoothly.

Clean and lubricate your press as needed. We recommend no more than 3,000 rounds loaded between cleaning and lube sessions.

#### Cleaning

- ◆ Use 409 or similar detergent cleaner to clean interior of case feeder. Never use petroleum based solvents on plastics.
- ♦ Use alcohol on a small patch to clean interior of primer magazine and pickup tubes.
- ♦ Use orange oil based "Gunk" hand cleaner to clean interior of powder hopper, to lighten it after extended powder storage in tube.
- ♦ Use alcohol to wipe off powder bars, and swab out interior of powder measure body where bars slide. Also use alcohol to clean interior of powder drop tube, powder funnel.
- ♦ Use alcohol to wipe off primer disc & primer seating punch

#### 550 Lubrication

- ♦ lube shaft with 30 wt motor oil
- ♦ lube all pivot pins with grease
- ♦ lightly grease short end of operating rod
- ♦ lightly grease head end of primer retaining pin
- ♦ lightly grease underside of shellplate bolt where it recesses into index sprocket
- ♦ lightly grease rails on connector body collar
- ♦ lightly grease roller on connector body collar

#### XL-650 Lubrication

- ♦ lube shaft with 30 wt motor oil
- ♦ lube all pivot pins with grease
- ♦ lightly grease interior of ring indexer, camming surface of ring indexer and indexer block.
- ♦ lightly grease the primer cam on the upper right side of the frame.
- ♦ lightly grease angled cam surface on slide cam
- ♦ lightly grease platform rails where case insert slide rides
- ♦ lightly grease ramp on case insert slide where camming pin contacts it
- ♦ lightly grease underside of shellplate bolt where it contacts top of shellplate.
- ♦ lightly grease rails on connector body collar
- ♦ lightly grease roller on connector body collar
- ♦ lightly grease primer disc pin
- ♦ heavily grease underside of station one locator where it fits into platform entension
