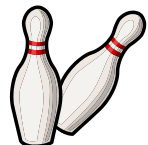

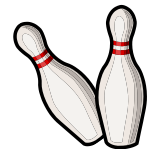

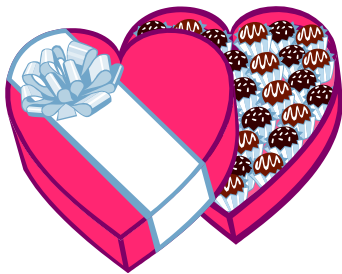

Politics & Legislation

As this is being written we have not reached the end of January and things are running hot and heavy on both the state and national levels.

We can start with a couple of counties in New York State that have printed the names and addresses of citizens who own legally licensed firearms with an interactive map to show their locations. The reasoning behind this invasion of privacy is to let the general public know where the dangerous guns are. You don't want to send your kids for a "play date" to a home where firearms are present.

What they have done is let the bad guys know where the guns are and where the unarmed easy targets are. They consider this a public service. Compromising gun owners is a public service?

His highness in Washington has signed 23 executive orders to restrict your rights guaranteed by the 2nd Amendment. Enhanced background checks (NICS), mental health registry, authorized the CDC to study gun violence, reinstate the "assault weapons" ban, limit ammo clips to 10 rounds; I also read 7 rounds in one report, enhanced rules against straw purchases, etc. Also the appointment of Todd Jones as director of the infamous BATF & E. Mr. Jones is not a friend of gun owners or of self-defense.

I watched the press conference exploiting children with VP Joe Biden making the statement that since the tragedy in Connecticut there have been 900 gun deaths in America. This number came from nowhere. I could not confirm this number with the FBI website, national record or any other source I tried. I guess if you start a press conference with a lie the rest is easy.

In New Hampshire, House Bill 135 has been introduced for the 2013 session. This is an act relative to physical force in defense of a person and relative to the definition of non-deadly force. The

sponsor is Rep. Shurtleff (D) Merrimack II. This will amend the law we fought for last year to keep situations like the Ward Bird case from happening in NH. 1) Eliminates the provision allowing a person to use deadly force anywhere he or she has a legal right to be. 2) Amends the definition of non-deadly force. 3) Repeals the provision granting civil immunity for the use of force in certain circumstances.

If this bill passes to amend RSA 627:4,III and RSA 627:9,IV and you find yourself in a dicey situation and only DISPLAY a firearm to diffuse the situation, you will at minimum spend

thousands of dollars for lawyers or possibly spend 2 or 3 years in jail.

There will be many calls for rallies from pro-gun organizations throughout the state. Attend as many as you can. A word of caution, the rallies are to draw media attention to the violations of our rights. Please leave the Camo gear at home. If you carry a firearm without a CCL make sure your clothing cannot cover the firearm at any time. We have to prove to a skeptical public that we are not the problem, that guns are not the problem, CRIMINALS AND MENTALLY DISTURBED INDIVIDUALS ARE THE PROBLEM!

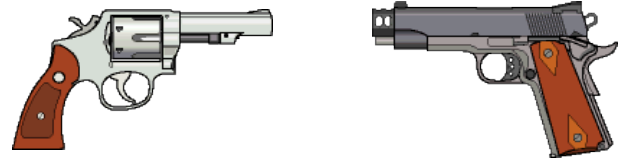

Iron Pony's Pueblo Red Chili

2 lbs beef
3 heaping tbsp red chili powder
1-cup beef broth
1-cup ripe tomatoes
1 large onion, chopped fine
6 coriander seeds
½ tsp garlic powder
1 tsp salt
2 tsp oregano
2 tsp cumin
1 seven oz can of Chipotle peppers

You will note there are no beans, or beer, or other unnecessary extras in this mix, the real thing is pretty much spices and beef. Try Pinto beans on the side along with flour tortillas, or better yet, corn bread for the juices.

Cut the beef into ½" cubes and boil it while you brown the onions in olive oil, mixing in the cumin, oregano, coriander, garlic, and salt.

Put the spices and beef broth (canned

is OK) into a crockpot or slow cooker, add in the chopped tomatoes, crushed coriander seeds, and, of course, the red chili powder. Once those are well combined, you can drain the beef and add it to the mix. Go away and shoot for a while then come back and taste test the results.

Once it's done cooking, for the extra Wow! factor, I add the final ingredient, a can of Chipotle peppers. These peppers are packed pretty much whole with tomato paste and some spices. I prepare them by mashing them with a fork on a cutting board, mixing the pepper meat, skins, seeds, and what tomato clings to them well, then into the pot with a good stir and let it all cook.

I've cooked a batch of this for up to 18 hours on low in the crockpot and it seems to get hotter and the meat more spice filled the longer it cooks.

Red chili amounts are to taste and the fresher the better. Garlic can be fresh or powder, the latter is easier. Aside from red chili, cumin is my favorite spice, so I have a tendency to go a little heavier on it than is listed

To speed up the process the spices and vegetables can be combined and set aside after browning ahead of time. Boil, then brown the meat in olive oil, drain, then combine everything in a pan and simmer for 30 minutes covered. I don't think its as rich as the slow cook way but it is faster.

To check the spice level I dip a flour tortilla into the juices and eat it. If the spices cause me to hiccup then it's about right, you can always add more red chili but remember to mix it well and let the new spice cook in with the old.
