## Politics & Legislation

The effort to filibuster the egregious Senate Bill S649 was shot down by Senate Democrats and sixteen Republican Senators. Unfortunately, our NH Senators, Jean Shaheen and Kelly Ayotte, voted to prevent the filibuster. It was expected that Senator Shaheen would vote against law-abiding citizens, but Senator Ayotte's vote was very disappointing and unexpected.

I have had a great deal of correspondence with both senators. Senator Shaheen gives the kind of non-committal answers that I have come to expect from Democrat/Progressive politicians. Senator Ayotte has been very forthcoming with her answers and has usually favored the view of law-abiding gun owners. The fact that her actions on this issue did not agree with her words is very disturbing. Her strategy on this bill hopefully will be revealed in our favor during debate on the issue.

The debate on this feel good legislation that will do absolutely nothing to prevent mass shootings of innocent

people should take a couple of weeks. There will be many amendments to the bill by the Democrat/Progressive elites to add draconian rules and regulations to curb the activities of law-abiding gun owners. Whatever state you reside in contact your senators many times during the debate process to convey your opposition to this bill.

*(Update: Senate Bill 649 died in the Senate on a 54-46 vote taken on 17 April. Senator Ayotte did indeed vote to kill the legislation; a victory for our side.)*

On the New Hampshire home front, HB135, the bill to repeal the "stand your ground" provision of current law, is alive and progressing in the legislature. There will be another hearing on this issue on 23 April. We hope to have many citizens attend this and other hearings to voice their opposition to any and all legislation that would infringe on our rights. Unfortunately, when it comes to political gamesmanship, our opponents are very adept at delay, confusion, and outright lying to get what they want. Gun

Owners of NH and the NRA/ILA have sent out alerts to try and "rally the troops" to our cause. The opposition knows this and this is when the delaying tactics and deliberate confusion come into play. They know the majority of the citizens who oppose anti-gun legislation are the ones who go to work every day and have to take time from their employment to support us. Don't be surprised or upset if they delay the vote on any firearms issue if they do not have the votes to pass what they want. This is a tactic they use VERY often.

Once again our country has been attacked by person or persons unknown to us for the purpose of terrorizing us into changing our way of life and curbing the freedoms we all enjoy. We hope that all Americans will stand firm and not let these murders of the innocent bend or break our will to be free and independent. Please keep the victims of this heinous act in your prayers and be ever vigilant in your daily lives to protect your loved ones and our country.

**Proposed Club Bylaw Changes**

The Country Pond Fish & Game Club Bylaws may only be modified by the General Membership.

At the next monthly Members meeting, to be held on 16 May, the following change to Bylaw 3.1 will be voted on. Reason: To create a requirement for sponsorship for new Club Members.

**3.1 An individual interested in membership shall submit an application for membership to the Vice President, then be interviewed by the membership Committee.**

shall be changed to add the following sections:

- a. Each prospective new Member must be sponsored by a current Club Member in good standing.
- b. Any Sponsor must have been a Club Member in good standing for at least two complete years immediately prior to sponsoring any new Member.
- c. Any couple joining as Family Members at the same time need only a single sponsor.
- d. If the prospective Member or Members are accepted as CPF&G Club Members, the Sponsor will share complete responsibility for the new Member's actions for one year.
- e. This section shall not apply to Honorary Members

At the next monthly Members meeting, to be held on 16 May, the following change to Bylaw 3.6 will be voted on. Reason: To change "Permanent" Member to "Senior" Member, and to correct an error.

**3.6 Permanent Senior Member**

- a. Must be a dues paying member for five (5) consecutive years ~~consecutively prior to age sixty five (65);~~
- b. Will be a voting member with full Club privileges and be exempt from dues and any other charges assessed the membership; and
- c. Must be sixty-five (65) years old and voted into ~~permanent Senior~~ membership at any regular meeting after the member's sixty fifth birthday, as requested by the member.

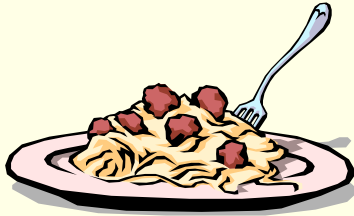
