Politics & Legislation

In Washington DC, the “smoke and mirrors” technique is once again in full operation. The Liar in Chief is using another crisis to advance his one-world agenda to control finances, medicine, and people, under the guise of firearm violence prevention, to bolster and implement his policies.

GOAL (Gun Owners Action League) of Massachusetts is working diligently to protect what firearms rights our Massachusetts members still have and to repeal some of the draconian laws on the books. The organization was there in force at the last Bill of Rights hearing that was held at the Gardner Auditorium in Boston this month. They have not published a report about the results of the hearing. In the July issue of “The GOAL News” they enumerated the 33 steps necessary to legally purchase a firearm in Massachusetts. After reading what these folks have to go through to purchase a firearm, it made me appreciate what we have here in NH. Even with all the faults we can find with our politicians they are angels compared to our southern neighbors' legislators.

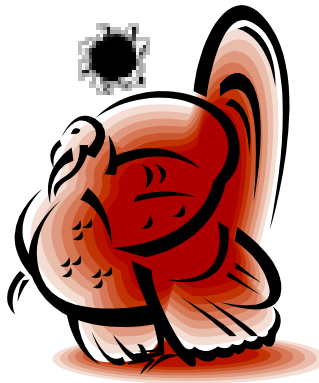
