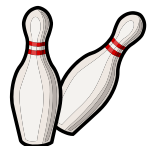

Politics & Legislation

New Hampshire

The New Hampshire legislative season begins January 8th. It is going to be very interesting to say the least. Some of the issues returning from the last session are Medicaid expansion under the Affordable Care Act, casino gambling, gas tax increase, and many others. The reason I mention these is the fact that there will be many distractions that may take away your attention from firearms issues.

Proposals are in the works for increased background checks, to restrict ownership of firearms, and prohibit firearms in public places. On the plus side, our allies in the legislature have proposed that firearms records should be exempt from the right-to-know law, out-of-state residents would be able to carry firearms in NH, and state law enforcement would be prohibited from enforcing federal gun laws if they conflict with NH law.

Just for the record, the House also has to act on 100 or more retained bills in the first three session days of the 2014 session. Our Senate usually takes its time with the bills it holds over. If what I am hearing about proposed legislation comes to fruition don't bother with a seat belt it's going to be a rocket sled ride this year. (It is an election year).

Massachusetts

The state Attorney General seems to have a problem with firearms. Citizens of MA that try to follow the law, by applying for a firearms license, are being abused with no relief and she refuses to investigate, or even acknowledge, the criminal activity by

state and local government, which continues to defy the law by delaying the issuance of the license in 40 days or less as stated in MGL c.140 s131. (01/14 NL)

Facing a challenge in balancing mental health privacy and public safety considerations, the gun violence task force appointed by House Speaker Robert DeLeo held its final hearing on 13 December, with a report to be issued in the following weeks, according to its chairman. A member of the committee said she heard gun legislation would be taken up early next year. "I think there are some thoughtful provisions in the various legislation," said Chairman Jack McDevitt, a Northeastern University criminal justice researcher, who declined to preview the contents of the report or the various sections that will be included.

Broadly speaking, the report will cover school safety, mental health, and gun licensure where the task force will aim

to "streamline our process and strengthen it," McDevitt told the News Service. (Source-GOAL newsletter).

Obviously our Mass members are going to have their own headaches this year.

I cannot express strongly enough the importance of joining the NRA, Gun Owners of America, Gun Owners Action League (MA) or Gun Owners of NH. One national organization and one local organization will not bankrupt you. I belong to all four of these fine organizations and I'm not broke plus I'm retired living on a fixed income.

As I stated earlier in this article, it is an election year and if we don't win at the polls this year, you might as well jump in that hole under the outhouse, because the firearms community will be up to their collective necks in it. Finding out if your preferred candidate is pro-gun or anti-gun before you vote is of the greatest importance. Our future as gun owners and gun users is in the balance.

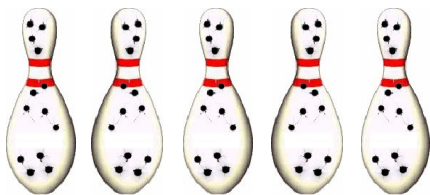

“Rate of Twist” & Bullet Weights

“Rate of Twist” indicates how far a bullet must travel (in inches) through a bore to make one full revolution. This is determined by the rate of rotation of the rifling. For example, a 9” twist barrel spins the bullet one full turn for every 9” it travels. In a 16” twist barrel, the bullet makes one revolution every 16”. So at the same bullet velocity, the 9” twist is faster (spins the bullet faster) than the 16” twist.

Too fast a twist overspins the bullet and may or may not result in reduced accuracy. A twist that is too slow for a bullet will likely produce instability, keyholing, and rotten accuracy. If you’ll be shooting only one bullet weight, choose a twist just fast enough to stabilize it. If you’re going to be using several bullet weights, select a twist that will stabilize the heaviest one, since lighter bullets will also be stabilized.
