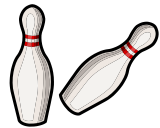

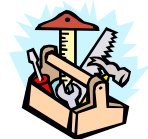

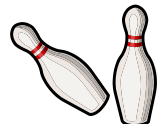

Politics & Legislation

Federal FYI: A pair of Democratic lawmakers are proposing steep new taxes on handguns and ammunition and tying revenues to programs aimed at preventing gun violence. Called the “Gun Violence Prevention and Safe Communities Act,” (HR 3018) the bill, sponsored by William Pascrell, D-NJ., and Danny Davis, D-IL., would nearly double the current 11 percent tax on handguns, while raising the levy on bullets and cartridges from 11 to 50 percent. They can’t curb firearm use by legislation so the new strategy seems to be to tax firearms and ammunition out of existence. This has been tried before and failed, but note they keep trying. They will keep trying until they get something they think will enhance their political wellbeing. Vigilance and grassroots activity are the weapons we must use to combat these unending attacks on our Second Amendment rights. (Source – FoxNews.com)

The Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms suggests that HR 3018 might even constitute a raid on the federal Pittman-Robertson Act, otherwise known as the Federal Aid to Wildlife Restoration Act, that has funneled hundreds of millions of dollars to state wildlife and natural resources agencies since it became law in 1937. The funds are apportioned back to the states by US Fish & Wildlife Service for wildlife restoration, habitat improvement and enhancement, range development, and hunter education.

Under the bill, the federal excise tax would be raised to 20 percent on pistols, revolvers and other firearms, and any “lower frame or receiver for a firearm, whether for a semiautomatic pistol, rifle, or shotgun that is designed to accommodate interchangeable upper receivers.” Clearly this is aimed at AR-15 type rifles and every handgun on the landscape and ammunition that is used by sport shooters, hunters, and armed citizens for personal protection.

“A 50 percent increase in the cost of ammunition that is already skyrocketing in price taxes people out of the market.” (Source – Alan Gottlieb, President CCRKBA)

New Hampshire FYI: Scott Brown, the former Senator from Taxachusetts, is scheduled to attend the next Gun Owners of NH meeting on May 20, 2014. The meeting starts at 7:00PM at the Holiday Inn in Concord, NH. I have tried to verify this information and the best I can do is tell you that his attendance is tentative. Like all politicians they go where they believe the largest crowds will be to hear their message of “hope and change.” Sound familiar? This would be a golden opportunity to see GONH members and directors in action on the legislative front all predicated on Mr. Brown’s attendance.

LEGAL NOTICE

Proposed Club Bylaw Change

At the next monthly Members meeting, to be held on 19 June, the following changes to Bylaw 3.7 will be voted on. Reason: to correct errors.

3.7 Life Member

a. Any member in good standing may apply for an individual Life Membership. ~~Family Members~~ **A Married Couple** in good standing may apply for ~~Family~~ **Married Couple** Life Membership.

b. A maximum of one hundred (100) Life Memberships will be available. For the purpose of this rule, a ~~Family~~ **Married Couple** Membership shall count as two Life Memberships.

c. Life memberships will be granted on a first come, first served, basis.

d. The cost for Life Membership shall be set as follows:

- (1) Individual Life Membership if the member is under 40 years of age: 12.5 times the existing Regular **Annual** Membership cost, rounded up to the nearest \$10 (ten dollars).
- (2) Individual Life Membership if the member is 40 years of age or over: 10 times the existing Regular **Annual** Membership cost, rounded up to the nearest \$10 (ten dollars).
- (3) ~~Family~~ **Married Couple** Life Membership if the average of the Members' ages is under 40: 12.5 times the existing ~~Family~~ **Married Couple Annual** Membership cost, rounded up to the nearest \$10 (ten dollars).
- (4) ~~Family~~ **Married Couple** Life Membership if the average of the Members' ages is 40 or over: 10 times the existing ~~Family~~ **Married Couple Annual** Membership cost, rounded up to the nearest \$10 (ten dollars).

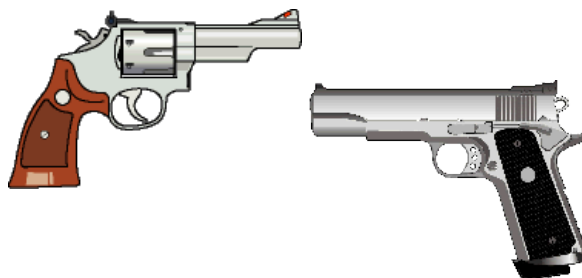
