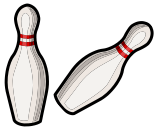

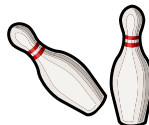

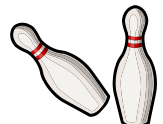

Politics & Legislation

Massachusetts

H.4121 An act relative to the reduction of gun violence. Sponsor- Mr. DeLeo

The Massachusetts Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee passed favorably, by one vote, this proposed legislation. The Bay State, with some of the harshest anti-gun laws on the books, now will have even more red tape and restrictions for its citizens to cope with, if this horrendous piece of work is passed into law by the legislature.

With all the laws regulating the use of firearms, which have little if any success at stopping gun violence in the state, the state legislators believe more restrictions will do the trick.

Following the logic of Massachusetts legislation has befuddled people smarter than I for many years. Probably one of the reasons I moved out of there thirty years ago.

The Massachusetts Gun Owners Action League (GOAL) has been in the forefront alerting citizens about this

legislation. Considering the narrow margin it passed out of committee, their efforts came close. What I can't understand is why the citizens of Massachusetts keep voting these legislators back into office, election cycle after election cycle. A lot of this type of legislation seems to narrowly pass all the time. Feel good legislation does nothing to protect anyone.

Things will never change in the state until all those who believe the Constitutions of the United States and Massachusetts actually mean something, put their petty differences aside and work together to elect legislators who also believe in these precious documents.

New Hampshire

The Gun Owners of New Hampshire (GONH) has been bombarded by requests from candidates for public office to attend our meetings to explain their position on our firearms rights and freedoms. Bob Smith, Jim Rubins, and, of course, Scott Brown,

and a lot of local and state candidates have addressed our meetings. I would request that all of my fellow NH citizens take the time to attend any candidate nights that may happen in your local area. If we weed out the candidates that seem to be saying what they think we want to hear about firearms issues, we can stop the kind of misery our southern neighbors have to live with from taking root here in the Granite state.

Electing politicians who flap in the breeze every time the political winds change direction does not bode well for a Constitutional state that puts the rights of all citizens before political correctness. We can right the ship of state we call New Hampshire if enough citizens pay attention to what is happening in Concord. We must start at the local level and pay attention all the way up to the "Golden Dome." It's our state; let's make sure all the candidates understand that simple, powerful fact.
