The Presidential campaign season is cranking up to full speed. New Hampshire will be inundated with potential candidates vying for your votes. My only request is for you to pay attention to what these folks are really saying. If you attend a candidate forum or town hall meeting, please be the one who asks the tough questions about Second Amendment rights.

There will be many distractions in the coming months due to the campaigning we all have to endure. Don't lose track of our state and local political shenanigans that will be ongoing during the campaigns.

SB 116, the bill to change the requirement for a CCL for law abiding citizens, passed both House and

Senate committees with an "ought to pass" recommendation. I have been informed that this bill may come up for a vote on April 23rd, but the bill is not listed on the legislative agenda. This is one of the ways political "hocus pocus" is used to delay or defeat legislation.

There are a lot of our illustrious legislators who do not want to go on the record voting against this bill.

Contacting your Representative or Senator about this legislation is crucial in letting our legislators know this bill is of great importance to Granite State residents.

Politicians pay attention to voting blocs, which is exactly what we are if we fight together for our rights. Large numbers of voters and large campaign

donations really get the attention of some of our legislators. Political activism can be frustrating and downright aggravating at times, but without you and me nipping at the heels of our political class, we could be in real trouble if we ignore them.

There are many politicians who work with us faithfully to craft legislation that benefit and enhance our rights under the state constitution; then there are some who's only concern is their political futures and getting reelected or elected to higher office. I can only urge you to vet candidates carefully before casting your important vote in any and all elections.

Your votes do count. Let them count for our freedoms and firearms rights.
