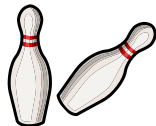

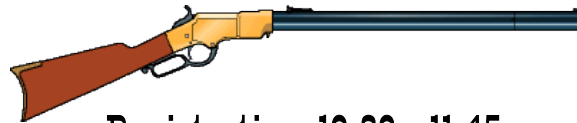

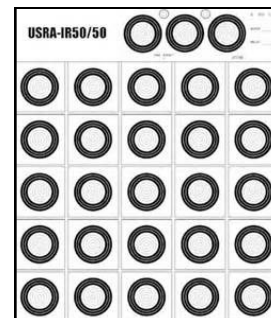

Why 3-Gun?



3-Gun is probably the most practical, useful, and adrenaline filled sport in the gun world today. The three guns it uses are the pistol (semi-automatic), the rifle (typically an AR-15), and the shotgun (pump or semi-auto).

It puts the participant in the position of having to shoot on the move, in a hurry, with multiple guns, in an obstacle course style race format.

Its hard to imagine a more useful way to train civilians to be prepared for a situation in which they may need to use a firearm to defend themselves or their family. 3-Gun competitions use the weapons that a person would most likely use in a self defense situation and simultaneously put the shooter under the pressure of a time constraint by making the competition a race.

When you're in a race, your adrenaline flows like crazy. Your fingers shake, you forget to disengage your safety, and you miss targets that would have otherwise been easy, because you're in such a rush and so pumped with adrenaline.

This is exactly what makes 3-Gun so important and useful. If someone breaks into your house in the middle of the night, do you think they're going to wait while you load your pistol, take aim, disengage the safety, and fire slow

well aimed shots? Of course not. You're going to be in the biggest rush of your life and your adrenaline is going to explode as you attempt to take action to save your family. This is when the quality of your training will show.

If you have never shot outside of slow paced, calm range shooting or hunting, you're going to be ill-prepared for a life or death engagement. You'll probably freeze up and make multiple deadly mistakes when it matters most.

If, on the other hand, you've repeatedly put yourself into training situations that require you to rush, that cause your adrenaline to pump, and that make you shoot fast and accurately, your body will do what its been trained to do through those previous training experiences. This is called muscle memory and it's the key to performing in stressful situations. When you are in a fight or flight mode, your conscious mind turns off and your body simply acts. Unless it's been trained to act in a certain way for such a situation, it will fail to do so. You don't have time to think through your decisions in a life or death emergency situation.

Many aspects of 3-Gun will be new to you when you first start out, such as:

- shooting while experiencing a major

adrenaline rush

- shooting rapid double taps
- shooting at multiple targets one after another as quickly as possible
- shooting close and far targets in rapid sequence
- safely switching weapons rapidly
- shooting on the move
- reloading rapidly under pressure

When you enter your first 3-Gun competition, you'll get to experience just how badly such a life or death situation would have gone without the proper training. You'll find yourself dropping magazines, forgetting to disengage the safety of your weapon, failing to quickly clear simple jams, missing shots that would normally be easy for you, taking what seems like an eternity to load another magazine, etc. This is how everyone starts out when they first enter the world of real time, real scenario shooting. There are always several competitors at every 3-Gun competition who are first-timers and who make more mistakes than you could imagine. No one will laugh at you. We're all here for the same reason: to get good; really good. You'll find expert 3-Gunners will cheerfully give you advice and tips on procedures, techniques, and equipment.

Politics & Legislation

SB 116 “Constitutional Carry” in New Hampshire – update:

This bill has passed the House and Senate and all the committees the Democrats can put it through. As of this writing, the bill should be on the Governor’s desk waiting her signature or her veto. The good news is the bill has not been changed or altered in anyway.

Is the Governor stonewalling this legislation? Is the Governor hoping that the firearms community is not paying attention? These are questions we cannot answer with any surety.

I have to commend our legislators for their efforts in ushering this bill all the way to Governor Hassan’s desk. It’s up to her now.

On the Federal level:

Mr. Mike Hammond, our inside the Washington DC beltway guy, addressed the recent GONH meeting with some of what is happening on the federal level. There are several bills conservatives are keeping a close eye on. The Highway Bill (infrastructure) that is being discussed is one of them. It seems certain Democrat legislators

are trying to get some not so friendly to gun owners language added to the bill. The counter to this action by conservatives would be to add national reciprocity to the bill. National Reciprocity is a “poison pill” to many Democrats who have championed gun control.

Mr. Hammond also informed us of a bill that will be proposed that will enact a penalty of five years in prison for any BATFE agent who removes any 4473 forms from FFL dealers. It is currently illegal for agents to remove these records for any reason other than a criminal investigation. It has been reported by dealers that BATFE agents have been intimidating dealers to release 4473’s or copy them for other than the purpose prescribed by law. As clear as this regulation is, because of the attitude of the current

administration in Washington, agents of the BATFE feel they are above the law. I’m sure there are agents who follow the letter and intent of this law but one agent who considers himself or herself above the law is a very dangerous precedent.

As you enjoy the summer months, be aware that Michael Bloomberg and the millions of dollars he has donated to “gun control” will be working very hard to undermine your Second Amendment rights. Your vigilance is as important during the so called “Washington off season” as it is during the legislative sessions. We are in a constant battle to preserve and protect our rights. If you rely on the other guy to put in the time and effort needed to keep us safe from “do gooder” politicians, we will all suffer the consequences.
