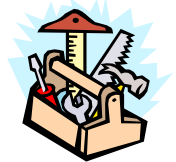

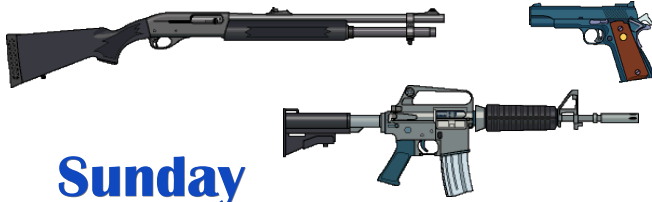

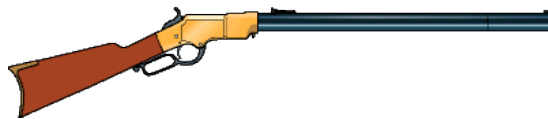

Politics & Legislation

Federal:

After being thoroughly entertained by the Democrat presidential candidates debating their ideologies, I was distressed by the fact they are still using firearms and firearm owners to gain political points from the political extremists that call themselves Americans.

Thomas Sowell is a senior fellow at the Hoover Institution, Sanford University. Mr. Sowell debunked their vitriol in an article published in the Union Leader of 14 October 2015. Here is an excerpt from his article.

“The zealotry of gun control advocates might make some sense if they had any serious evidence that more restrictive gun control laws actually reduce gun crimes. But they seldom even discuss the issue in terms of empirical evidence. Saving lives is serious business. But claiming to be saving lives and refusing to deal with evidence is a farce. Nor is the Second Amendment or the National Rifle Association the real issue, despite how much the media and intelligentsia focus on them”.

The Democrat heir apparent (Hillary) stated that she will “circumvent Congress” to change and strengthen gun laws. Where has our country gone if a candidate for President of the United States can aver circumventing Congress and the Constitution of the United States and still be considered a serious contender for the White House?

New Hampshire:

One of the bills that has flaws that we fought to amend.

124:1 Pistols and Revolvers; License to Carry. Amend RSA 159:6, I to read as follows:

1.(a) The selectmen of a town, the mayor or chief of police of a city or a full-time police officer designated by them respectively, the county sheriff for a resident of an

unincorporated place, or the county sheriff if designated by the selectmen of a town that has no police chief, upon application of any resident of such town, city, or unincorporated place, or the director of state police, or some person designated by such director, upon application of a nonresident, shall issue a license to such applicant authorizing the applicant to carry a loaded pistol or revolver in this state for not less than 4 years from the date of issue, if it appears that the applicant has good reason to fear injury to the applicant's person or property or has any proper purpose, and that the applicant is a suitable person to be licensed. Hunting, target shooting, or self-defense shall be considered a proper purpose. The license shall be valid for all allowable purposes regardless of the purpose for which it was originally issued.

The phrases “good reason” and “suitable person” appear in many of the firearm laws prevalent in the state south of our border. This is the slippery slope we should all fear here in the Granite State.

“Good reason” and “suitable person” are not defined in any law that I can find, meaning it is left up to the discretion of the issuing authority. Ambiguity in the wording of laws is a dangerous place for the people governed by those laws.

We will attempt to keep our members well informed of the activities happening “under the golden dome”, as it is called by some in the media, which will be a call to firearm owners to defend their rights.

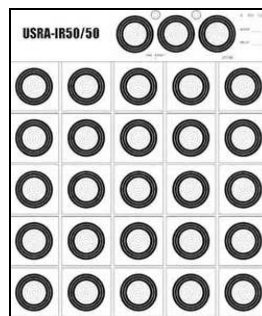
