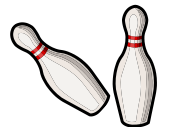

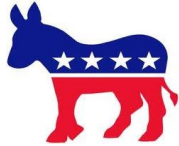
ANNUAL MEETING & CLUB ELECTIONS 17 DECEMBER

Politics & Legislation

Our legislators in Concord are gearing up for what appears to be an interesting session in an election year. Our governor is running for the US Senate. Our legislators are filing Legislative Service Requests (LSRs) like there is no tomorrow. If we get lucky some of the LSR's will not have a political tomorrow.

Here are some of the LSRs that have been filed for consideration:

2366: Limiting authority of state entities to regulate the sale, use and possession of firearms. (Favorable)

2437: Defining suitable person for the purpose of obtaining a license to carry a firearm and extending the term of the license. (Favorable)

2558: Establish criminal penalty for providing to a person prohibited from possessing a firearm. (Questionable)

2559: Requiring firearm owners to have liability insurance. (Negative)

2561: Prohibiting firearms in certain public places. (Negative)

2562: Requiring collection of data relative to firearm related deaths and injuries. (Questionable - wording)

2564: Relative to the theft of a firearm during a burglary. (Negative - wording could ruin this)

2770: Relative to immunity for injuries from the possession or use of a firearm by an employee or official of a political subdivision. (Questionable - should cover any legal gun owner)

2563: Relative to funding for state background checks. (Questionable - expanding checks or just funding)

2017: Relative to carrying a pistol or revolver without a license. (Unknown - bill from last session for "Constitutional Carry" that was tabled will be on the agenda. This bill may not be necessary.)

2212: Relative to carrying a rifle or shotgun in certain vehicles. (Questionable - wording)

Gun Owners of New Hampshire (GONH) will be monitoring the progress of these and other LSR's that may affect your firearms rights. The questionable ratings denote the language of the final bill is unsure. The negative ratings are based on some of the sponsors past negative voting history on firearms issues and the specific wording yet to be introduced.

Some of the other issues faced by the legislature are drug abuse, the Heroin crisis, medical funding, etc. This coming session is a tough one for them. It could be a very tough one for firearm owners considering the pressure coming from the current administration in "Fantasy Land" (Washington, DC). The push for so called "Gun Control" in the guise of safety issues, terrorist intervention, security for our everyday activities, etc., are going to be major issues in a Presidential election year.

Hopefully, politicians who advocate restricting our firearms rights, with the current threats we are facing and future threats we may face, will find themselves retired from politics when the voters are heard in November 2016.
