# Politics & Legislation

Senate Bill 12, the repeal of the requirement of a license to carry a firearm concealed, is in Governor Sununu’s office awaiting his signature.

As usual, the NH Association of Chiefs of Police is adamantly opposed to this legislation. Let’s examine some of their “concerns” about this bill. They say that, under the current system, an officer at a traffic stop or a police call has the benefit of knowing whether their local chief has issued a license for someone to carry a concealed handgun.

According to the NH Police Academy, all officers are trained to approach all situations with the assumption that someone may be armed. So the advantage of knowing of a CCL holder is what? My CCL issued by my local Chief of Police is good throughout the entire state. So, once again, the advantage whether their local Chief has or has not issued your CCL is?

Under this bill your CCL can still be issued to you if you want. Our state has reciprocity with 27 other states but you need a CCL to legally carry in that state.

This gives those of us who carry while traveling the advantage of reciprocity. Obviously, “Constitutional Carry” states do not require a license.

Senate Bill 12 recognizes the right of every law-abiding citizen in New Hampshire to a firearm for self-defense, without having to beg the government for a license. There has been a lot of lobbying against this legislation by a paid professional lobbying group. I wonder where the money to pay them comes from? The name Bloomberg comes to mind.

In my opinion, some chiefs of police are worried about losing some of their power over the citizenry. The other issue may be that the fees charged for CCL’s go directly to the issuing authority. Are they worried about the loss of a revenue stream?

If you have not heard or read about the governor signing SB 12 by the time you read this article, please pick up the phone and call the Governor’s office and urge him to sign this important legislation.

On 15 February, the NH House of Representatives defeated a bill to ban firearms in polling places, by a vote of 204-144. Opponents of the proposed ban said citizens should not be denied their Constitutional right to carry a firearm at the polls, even if it is in a school.

There are more legislative proposals that are being scrutinized by our local and state firearm advocacy groups. We will keep vigilant with your help and support.

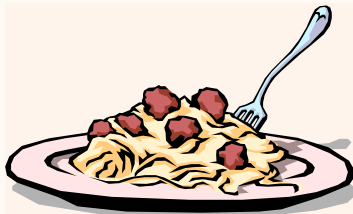
