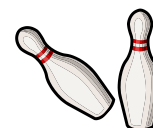

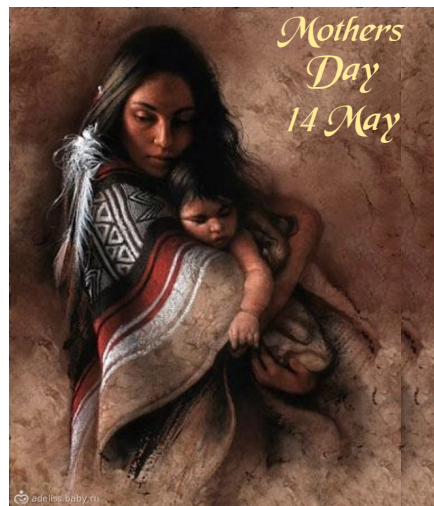

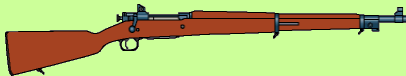

Politics & Legislation

There is a statewide debate about the pending appointment of David Patch to the New Hampshire Fish & Game Commission. Notwithstanding Mr. Patch's conservation efforts on the behalf of our wildlife, his political views toward our Second Amendment rights are not a stellar performance. He adamantly opposed Constitutional Carry in lock step with the Chiefs of Police Association.

He also stated his opposition to amending the RSA that allows Fish & Game officers to issue citations for having a loaded rifle or shotgun in a vehicle. The problem with this RSA, as the Gun Owners of NH and the NH Firearm Coalition have recently learned, is that some F&G officers have been overzealous in their enforcement of this RSA. For example – asking to see one's hunting permit while the hunter is preparing to enter his vehicle. If the person places his rifle or shotgun in the bed of his vehicle or the backseat to comply with the officer's request, and does not unload said firearm, he is then cited for having a loaded rifle/shotgun in his vehicle.

We are working on legislation with our political allies to try and alleviate these types of actions on the part of some F&G officers.

On the national scene – HR 1181, which would restore firearm rights to veterans who had their rights suspended without due process, has passed the House by a vote of 240-175. The bill is now pending in the Senate. Approximately 257,000 veterans have been offended by this Obama administration folly.

HR38, The National Reciprocity Act, is picking up momentum in the House. In my opinion, this is a great idea, but if this passes the US House and Senate and becomes law I'll start believing in the Easter Bunny again!

The Obama administration's ban on firearm ownership of Social Security recipients who need fiduciary assistance (when someone helps you

pay your bills or organize your daily activities) has been stopped by an Executive Order recently signed by President Trump.

The number of friends we have inside the Washington Beltway seems to be growing and pro-active about the Second Amendment. Let's hope it's not all smoke and mirrors as it has been in the past. We need politicians on our side as we continue to fight for our rights.

Vigilance works. Political activism works. Informed firearm owners works. Staying united is the only way we can pass on our firearm rights to future generations.

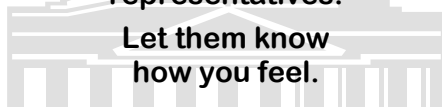

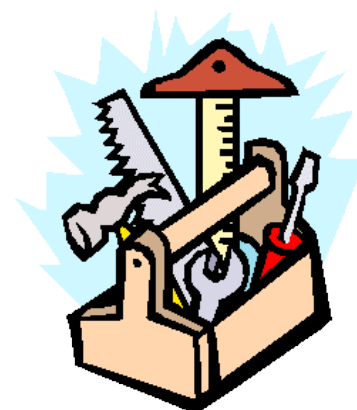
