Proposed Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following proposed changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws have been submitted. These changes have been reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors, and will be voted on at the next regular Monthly Meeting.

In an effort to streamline things and consolidate paperwork, the Constitution and the Bylaws, currently two separate documents, are being combined into one, consisting of two chapters.

Chapter 1: Constitution

Article V: Board, Officers and Membership

Section 5.7 Member:

Change:

All persons accepted into membership by a vote of the membership at a regular meeting, after having complied with the Bylaws of the Club for membership, shall have all rights, privileges, and responsibilities of full membership, to include:

to add:

“subject to conditions pertaining to individual membership classes, as specified in the Club Bylaws, “between “full membership” and “to include”

So as not to allow a contradiction between the two Chapters

Chapter 2: Bylaws

Article I: Duties of the Officers

Subsection 1.4c:

Change:

shall, **before** receiving any money,

to read:

shall, **upon** receiving any money,

So as to actually make sense

Subsection 1.4d:

Change :

shall maintain a **Club checking account;**

to read:

shall maintain **all Club financial accounts as may be required;**

So as to allow for the establishment and maintenance of other accounts

Article II: Boards

Subsection 2.2b:

Change:

shall bring **all major expenditures** before the membership

to read:

shall bring **all expenditures, other than any regular operating expenses (i.e. utilities, taxes, insurance, etc.) or those exceeding the authority of the Board of Directors,** before the membership

So as to more accurately define “major” and more clearly show the intent of this Section

Article V: Monies

Section 5.3:

Change:

six hundred dollars (\$600.00)

to read:

fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)

So as to establish a more realistic amount (Due to inflation, \$600 in 1952 dollars is equivalent to \$5,546.15 in 2017 dollars)

Article VII: Proceeds and Expenses

Section 7.2:

Change:

All events must be financially self-sustaining by the end of their **second** season. Failure to do so, or failure to maintain financial sustainability thereafter, on a **three** year moving average basis, shall result in a cancellation of the event.

to read:

All events must be financially self-sustaining by the end of their **third** season. Failure to do so, or failure to maintain financial sustainability thereafter, on a **two** year moving average basis, shall result in a cancellation of the event.

So as to correct a transposition error

Article IX: Dues and Surcharges

Subsection 9.1a:

Change:

Any Regular or Family Member

to read:

Any Regular Member

Because there is no such category as Family Member

Subsection 9.3:

Change:

Members not renewing by that date **will be non-members.**

to read:

Members not renewing by that date **will forfeit their Club membership.**

So as to be more specific in its meaning

Subsection 9.5:

Change:

enrollment fee

to read:

orientation fee

Because there is no such thing as a Club enrollment fee

Article XII: Amendments and Revisions

Section 12.1:

Change:

shall be outlined in detail in the Club newsletter to be mailed no later than ten (10) days before the monthly meeting.

to read:

shall be outlined in detail in the Club newsletter to be mailed **or published** no later than ten (10) days before the monthly meeting.

Because the Club no longer sends notices by US Mail

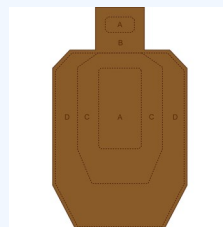

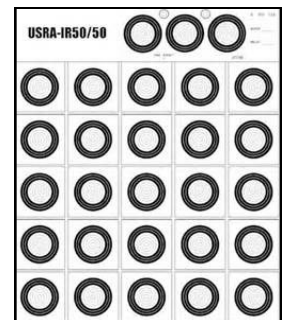
