#### New Hampshire

HB 1380: An act relative to unauthorized use of firearms.

This bill allows for discharge of a firearm within the compact part of a city or town, with the written permission of all abutting property owners.

Current law states: with written permission of the chief of police or governing body.

Getting written permission from your neighbors may be a lot easier than from the chief of police or selectmen. If the bill makes it to a vote as currently written, it could be beneficial to some gun owners.

HB 1438: An act relative to residential leases including provisions prohibiting tenants from possessing firearms, explosives, or ammunition within the premises.

Prohibiting explosives from residential property is not, in my opinion, a bad idea. Prohibiting firearms and ammunition is another matter. More investigation into the intent of this proposed legislation will be conducted before a recommendation is issued.


HB 1424-FN: An act relative to the penalty for attempts to purchase firearms illegally.

This bill increases the penalties for attempting to illegally purchase a firearm. As we all know, falsifying the documentation when purchasing a firearm is a federal offense. Considering the screw ups by the Feds, amending state law RSA 159-D:3 may not be a bad idea. If the Feds do prosecute, the state charges are usually dropped. If there is no federal prosecution, the state has recourse. We will keep an eye on the final wording of this bill when it comes out of committee.

Now that NH has a version of Constitutional Carry, a word of warning: If you carry a concealed

The "bump stock" issue update: Unlike real machineguns, semi-auto firearms do not have a stated cyclic rate. They will only fire as fast as a shooter can pull, then release, then pull the trigger again. Two people shooting the same firearm will shoot it at different speeds. There are many lawful devices that will allow someone to shoot a semi-auto firearm faster. The list of







prohibited items will be virtually endless and could even include magazines that use a heavier than normal spring to feed cartridges into the firearm. We should be very aware of what the slippery slope accessory bans could be.

NH Fish and Game Commission: The facts are not in dispute, not by the Commissioners, not by the Executive Council, and not by anyone who has been paying even the slightest amount of attention to this important issue; that on January 11, 2017 the New Hampshire Fish and Game Commission voted unanimously to oppose SB 12, Constitutional Carry.

I hope this answers some of the questions being asked about the F &G Commission.
