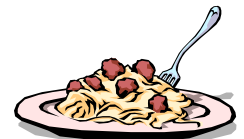

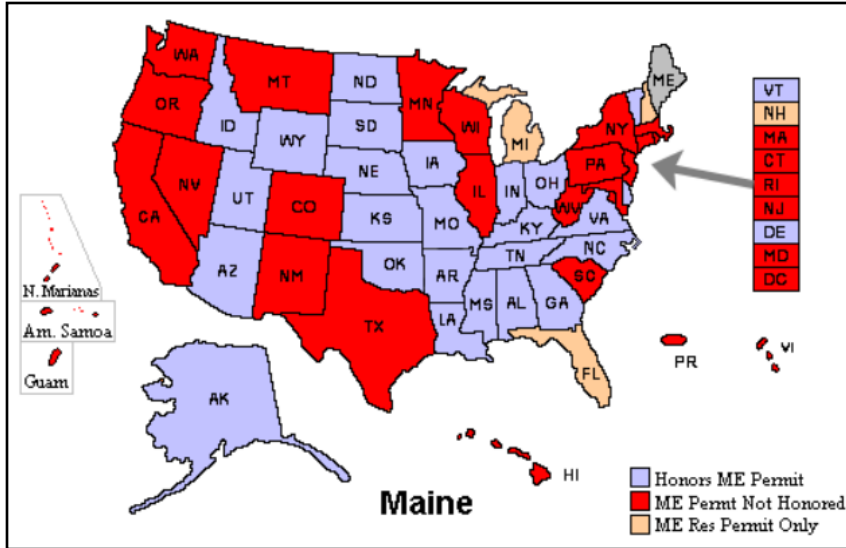

Your Right to Defend Yourself?



These maps show where you can legally carry a concealed firearm if you have a Maine, New Hampshire, or Massachusetts License to Carry a Concealed Weapon.

Alaska, Arizona, Kansas, Maine, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, Vermont, and West Virginia have "Permitless Carry." Anyone who can legally possess a firearm may carry it concealed in those states without a Permit or License. Idaho, North Dakota, and Wyoming have "Permitless Carry" for their Residents only.

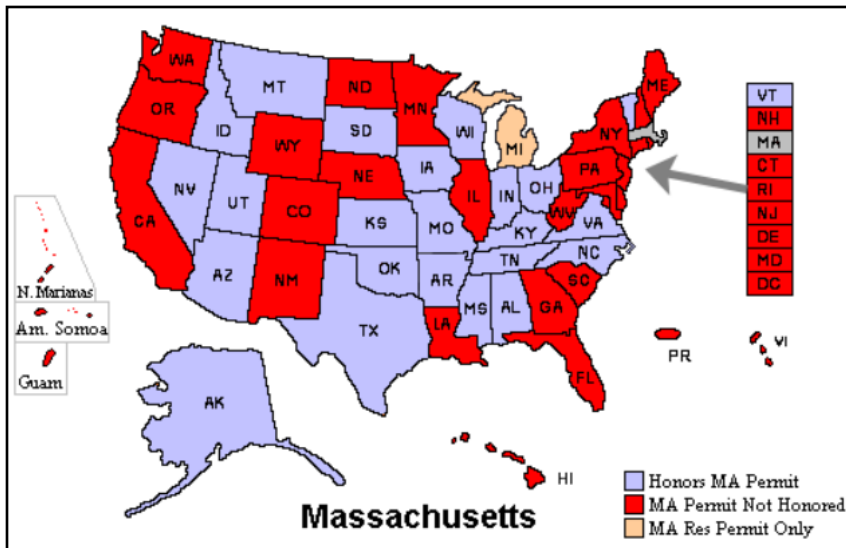
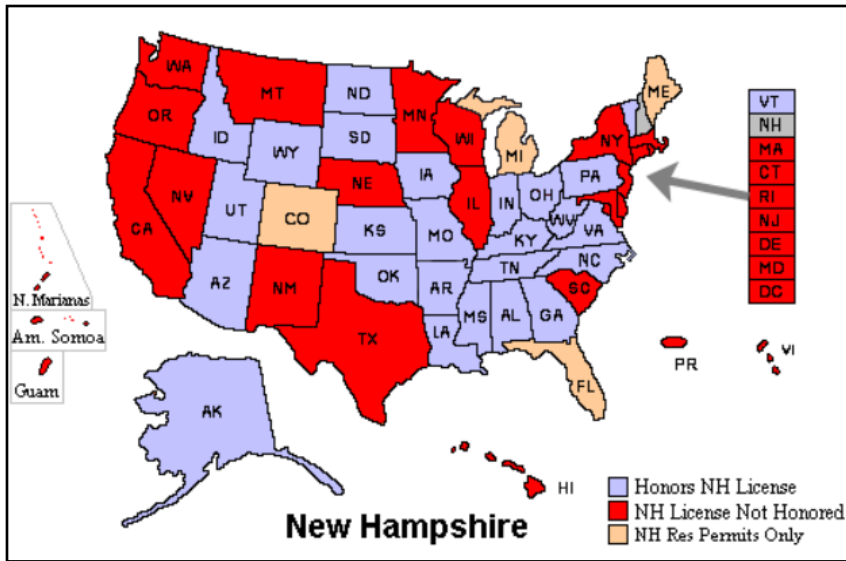
Anyone who can legally possess a firearm can carry it concealed in Maine under their Permitless Carry Law. Maine also honors Resident Licenses or Permits, and only from Alaska, Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, New Hampshire, North Dakota, North Carolina, Nebraska, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Virginia, & Wyoming.

Anyone who can legally possess a firearm can carry it concealed in New Hampshire under their Permitless Carry Law. New Hampshire also honors Resident Licenses from Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, & Wyoming

New Hampshire does not honor Non-Resident Permits or Licenses. You must be a resident of the state they honor for your permit to be valid in New Hampshire.

Massachusetts doesn't honor Permits or Licenses from any other states at all.

Politics & Legislation

SB 500 Update, thanks to Rep. JR Hoell (R) New Hampshire Firearm Coalition Secretary. (J. Faro)

Yesterday, NHFC President Alan Rice (who also represents GOA), and Vice President Paul Marquis, attended the Senate Judiciary Committee hearing on SB 500. Paul spoke for NHFC and Alan spoke for GOA. This hearing was interesting ; normally a bill's sponsor is the first to speak. The sponsor will introduce the bill and explain what the intention of the bill is, what problems the bill is attempting to solve, and how it will do these things. That is not what happened. Yesterday, the prime sponsor, Senator Kevin Avard was the first to address the committee, but instead of talking about SB 500, he instead went on a tirade against you.

Senator Avard told the Committee that NHFC sent a flyer into his district (he submitted a copy for the committee record). Sen. Avard complained about the number of calls and emails he received, and how much time it was taking to respond to them. Instead of listening to the grassroots gun owners who have legitimate concerns about SB 500, he demanded an apology. When it was Alan's turn to speak he told the committee that NHFC will continue to mail and email gun owners and ask them to take action that will protect their civil right to be armed. He was clear there will not be an apology.

In an affront to you, and all the gun owners who called and wrote to Sen. Avard to object to SB 500, the Senator appears to be taking direction from anti-gun activists and lobbyists. Instead of telling the committee he made a mistake and to kill the bill as you requested, Sen. Avard offered an amendment, 2018-0046s, to SB 500, an amendment that will make the bill even more anti-gun. It still references federal law, and even adds reference to federal law to yet another section of the NH RSAs, but the difference is that it specifies "in effect on January 1, 2018".

While this guards against future negative changes; what if Congress passes the Hearing Protection Act and deregulates sound suppressors? That would not benefit Granite Staters, because we would be stuck with the old federal law forever? On January 1, 2018, 18 USC 921 included in the definition of a firearm: frames, receivers, and silencers. This amendment does not help us.

Just think, after all the hard work to make it lawful to hunt with a sound suppressor in New Hampshire, the anti-gun activists who are giving advice to Sen. Avard would then treat these accessories as firearms.

We are entirely uncomfortable with the language defining "loaded". It appears that if a rifle is loaded and not ready to fire, that is the safety is on, a person could carry it in a motor vehicle. However, that can potentially set up a gun owner for an unknowing offense, possibly costing tens of thousands of dollars in legal fees. We

have advocated for many years for a complete repeal of the possessory only ban on loaded rifles in vehicles. It is unclear how this language will be interpreted by a court. A clean repeal will protect gun owners and leave no room for misinterpretation. The Avard language leaves it up to a judge to decide if you can carry a loaded rifle or shotgun in your car.

It is never a good idea to tie state law to federal law. Federal law can change, and we here in New Hampshire might not like that change. However, once the federal definitions change, New Hampshire gun owners would be bound by that change in definitions. Right now, federal law defines firearms to include frames, receivers, and silencers. None of these items can fire live ammunition, yet federal law includes these items in the definition of a firearm. Why would we want to mimic the anti-gun definition contained in the 1968 federal Gun Control Act?
