CPFGC's FFL Program: What are YOU waiting for?

I have been an active CPFGC Member for almost eight years. I joined the club before I even had a firearm. My expectation that CPFGC would be a great place to learn about firearms and firearm safety was more than surpassed. Since I joined in the early Fall, I figured that my first firearm should be a handgun as I would probably be shooting it indoors that Winter... a good call. I joined with a friend of mine and both of us needed to purchase our first firearms. We had a good time researching various firearms and we narrowed down our selections by visiting local firearms stores to see, touch, and feel our selections. We also enrolled in, and successfully completed, an NRA Basic Pistol Safety Course at CPFGC. Lastly, we approached the late, great Earl Tibbetts (who ran CPFGC's FFL Program back then) to request his input (he referred to it as "wisdom"), which he eagerly provided. He took our final selections, priced them out, and placed our orders. I ended up with a Sig P226 Elite 40 S&W and my friend a 9mm Springfield XDM - both exactly what we were looking for. As a side note, I am glad that I went with the 40 S&W as Earl said that I did not have to sit down when I peed like my 9mm friend had to going forward.

So what does the CPFGC FFL Program mean to me?

1. Knowledge. First Earl, and now Jeff, Andy, and Paul, are always there to provide their honest input to my questions. They have steered me away from questionable purchases, offered alternative selections and provided excellent "intel". I just identify a potential firearm, send Jeff an email, and typically within 24 hours get the availability and pricing for my selected firearm. This "intel" is awesome, and leads us to:

2. Cost Savings. As CPFGC's FFL Program is a 100% volunteer program, these guys have regular "day jobs" and cannot search the world high and low; they depend on a handful of dealers that they have used over the years. The majority of my requests are substantially lower in cost as the club gets the wholesale price. Even after tacking on the 5% Club fee and modest shipping costs, the total cost is far less than what I can get on my own. If I am able to "beat" the club's price - it does happen from time to time - I can still use CPFGC's FFL Program to transfer my firearm from the dealer that I chose for \$20 (covers multiple firearm purchases from the same dealer); this fee is typically half of what the local firearm stores charge. Lastly,

3. Satisfaction. Dealing with Jeff, Andy, and Paul is low stress and really a good time. We spend way too much time on the Internet. I know that the firearms I am buying are at a fair price,

high quality, and will meet (typically exceeding) my expectations. They are great guys so you should contact them for your next firearm purchase and see what they can do for you!

Once your selections have been narrowed down to one or two, send an email to Jeff identifying the manufacturer, complete name of the firearm, model #, product or SKU #, and the manufacturer's website link to the specific firearm. Then sit back and wait for Jeff to do his thing (don't get too comfortable as he doesn't take very long to respond). If one of the dealers that the club uses has the firearm available, just instruct Jeff to complete the order. If not, the effort is still worth while as you will know what the price is and can look for it elsewhere (and not pay too much). You can always wait a few months and check back again. Remember, if you do purchase a firearm from a dealer that involves a transfer, utilizing the Club can save you some money as the Club's transfer cost is typically less than the local firearms stores. When the firearm arrives at the Club, you will be notified and can set up a mutually agreeable time to meet for the transfer. You complete the background check form, your information is called in, and you are good to go (provided that your background check is approved).

So once again, what are YOU waiting for?

Proposed Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following proposed changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws have been submitted. These changes have been reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors, and will be voted on at the next regular Monthly Meeting.

(This proposal was previously submitted, but was withdrawn for revision, reducing the hours required as specified in Sections 3.10.d and 3.10.e.)

To change Bylaw Section 3.2:

3.2 There will be five classes of membership:

- a. Regular
- b. Military
- c. Honorary
- d. Senior
- e. Life

to read:

3.2 There will be six classes of membership:

- a. Regular
- b. Military
- c. Honorary
- d. Senior
- e. Life
- f. Probationary

To add Bylaw Section 3.10:

3.10 Probationary Member

- a. A newly accepted Club Member shall be considered Probationary for one full year, starting on the date voted in as a Club Member.
- b. Probationary Members must meet all the requirements as set forth under the Section regarding Regular Members.
- c. Subject to the conditions set forth in the following parts of this section, Probationary Members shall have all the rights and privileges of Regular Members.
- d. During their Probationary year, the Member must work a minimum of sixteen (16) hours at Club Saturday Work Parties. All hours worked must be approved by the appropriate Work Party Coordinator. Any Probationary Member who fails to comply with this requirement shall be refused the right to apply for Membership Renewal.
- e. Any new Member accepted under the Married Couples Discount provision must work a minimum of eight (8) hours at Club Saturday Work Parties. All hours worked must be approved by the appropriate Work Party Coordinator. Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in the Member being refused the right to apply for Membership Renewal.
- f. Time spent acting as Event Coordinator, Match Director, or other primary leadership position for a recurring Club event shall be credited towards the work hours requirement.
- g. This Section shall not apply to Honorary Members.

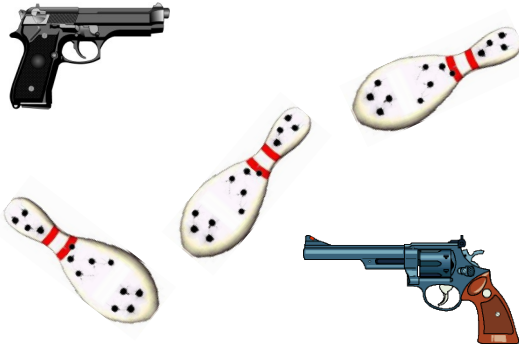

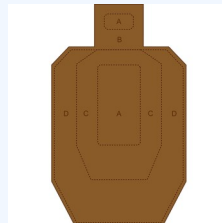
