Proposed Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following proposed changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws have been submitted. These changes will be voted on at the next regular Monthly Meeting, and are subject only to a "Yes" or "No" vote, as any changes would require reposting in the next Newsletter before they could be voted on at a subsequent meeting.

PROPOSED CHANGE #1

To change Bylaws Section 3.6, which currently reads:

3.6 Senior Member

- a. Must be a Member in good standing for a minimum of five (5) consecutive years and who has reached the age of sixty-five (65);
- b. will be a voting member with full Club privileges and be exempt from Club dues and Orientation fees; and
- c. **must be sixty-five (65) years old and voted into Senior Membership at any regular meeting after the member's sixty-fifth birthday, as requested by the member**

to read:

- a. Must be a Member in good standing for a minimum of five (5) consecutive years and who has reached the age of sixty-five (65);
- b. will be a voting member with full Club privileges and be exempt from Club dues and Orientation fees; and
- c. **must submit a request for Senior Membership at any regular meeting, or to the Vice-President during the membership renewal months.**

PROPOSED CHANGE #2

To change Bylaws Section 10.3, which currently reads:

- 10.3 The last day for renewal of membership is the last day of the year. Members not renewing by that date will forfeit their Club membership. **A Senior member may appear before the Board to plead their case and request membership reinstatement if said deadline has been missed.**

to read:

- 10.3 The last day for renewal of membership is the last day of the year. Members not renewing by that date will forfeit their Club membership. **A Senior member shall be reinstated, without penalty, by submitting a renewal form to the Vice president if said deadline has been missed.**

Changes Made to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

The following change to the Club Bylaws was approved at the April general meeting.

9.1 At the **November meeting** the Nomination Committee shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors.

9.2 They shall be responsible for the collection and the validation of all **petitions of the nomination**.

9.3 The petition shall include a statement of nomination, the nominee's name and a minimum of four (4) signatures of Club members, one of **them** may be a member of the committee.

was changed to read:

9.3 The petition shall include a statement of nomination, the nominee's name and a minimum of four (4) signatures of Club Members, one of **whom** may be a member of the committee.

9.5 **They** shall present all valid petitions to the general membership at annual meeting.

was changed to read:

9.5 **The Committee** shall present all valid petitions to the general membership at **the** annual meeting.

Sections 9.8 and 9.9 were added

9.8 Nominations shall be opened at the beginning of the September Monthly Meeting.

9.9 Nominations will be accepted from the floor at the September, October, and November monthly meetings, as well as at the Annual Meeting. To permit the orderly printing of ballots for the Annual Meeting, the period for Nominations by petition shall be closed at the end of the November Monthly Meeting.
