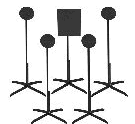

Changes Made to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

The following changes to the Club Bylaws were approved at the May general meeting.

Bylaws Section 3.6c, which read:

- c. must be sixty-five (65) years old and voted into Senior Membership at any regular meeting after the member's sixty-fifth birthday, as requested by the member

was changed to read:

- c. must submit a request for Senior Membership at any regular meeting, or to the Vice-President during the membership renewal months.

Bylaws Section 10.3, which read:

- 10.3 The last day for renewal of membership is the last day of the year. Members not renewing by that date will forfeit their Club membership. A Senior member may appear before the Board to plead their case and request membership reinstatement if said deadline has been missed.

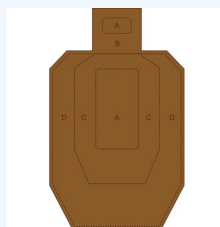

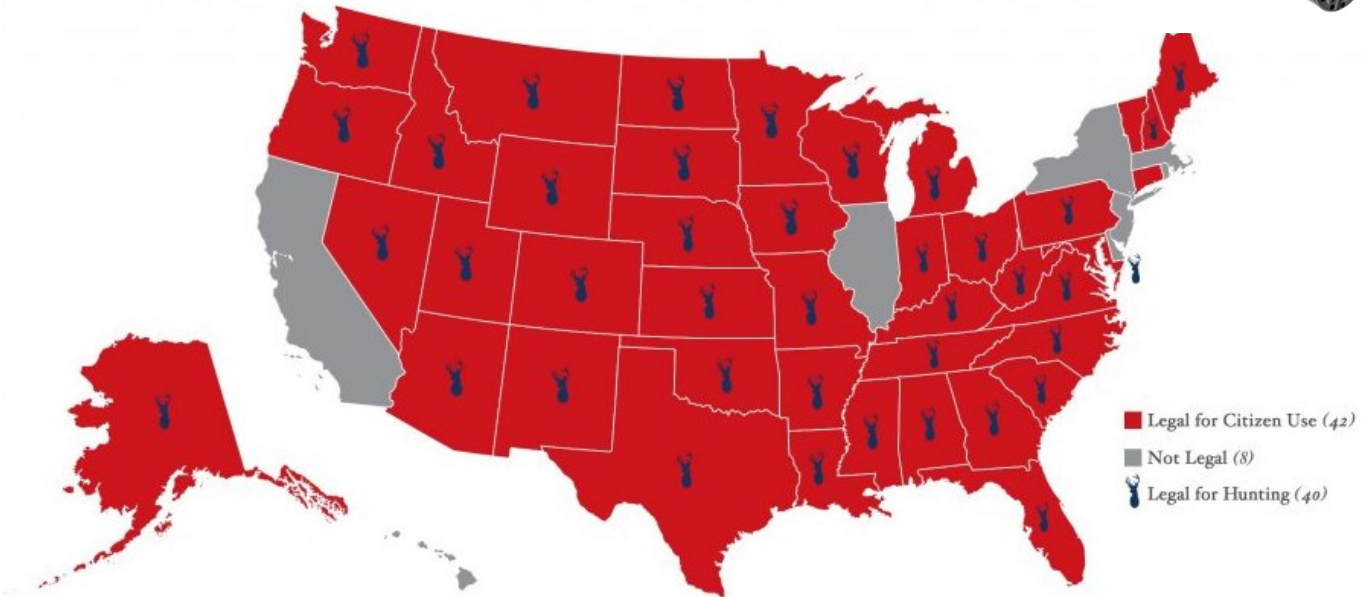

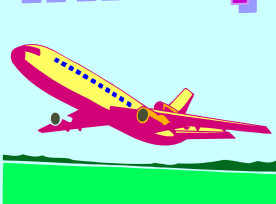
Are suppressors legal to possess in your state? Finding that out is the very first step in the lengthy process of buying a suppressor.
