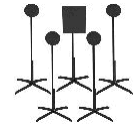

Misfire, Squib, or Hangfire?

Most of us are familiar with misfires. A misfire is when you press the trigger, the hammer or firing pin falls, but the cartridge doesn't fire.

A lot of us are familiar with squib loads as well. That's when you expect a "Bang" but get a "Pop". Did the bullet make it out of the barrel? Better check before you fire the next round. That does NOT mean "look down the barrel". Use your brain.

Do you know what a "hangfire" is? It's when there's a noticeable delay between the time the hammer falls and the cartridge fires. It could be a fraction of a second or even several seconds.

If you have a misfire (*which is always a potential hangfire*), the correct thing to do is to keep the muzzle pointed downrange for some period of time. The NRA recommends 30 seconds.

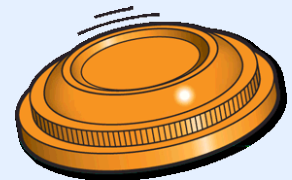
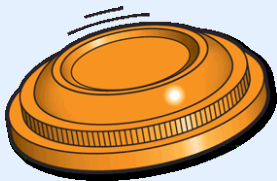

Politics & Legislation

The four bills plaguing New Hampshire gun owners are heading for the Governor's desk. They are HB 109, "Sell a gun to a friend and go to jail"; HB 514, "Buy a gun, go home without it"; HB 564, "Criminal safe schools"; and HB 696, "Elder care gun confiscation".

HB 109, HB 514 & HB 564 should be headed to the veto pile. All the New Hampshire pro-firearm organizations have been informed by the Governor's office that he will veto these unnecessary changes to the state's firearm statutes.

HB 109 is the expanded background check legislation. If you want to sell or give a firearm to a family member or friend, you would have to go through an FFL dealer for a background check. The Governor has said he would veto this type of legislation.

HB 514 would add a "waiting period" when you purchase a firearm before you can take possession of the firearm. This bill is also slated for a veto.

HB 564 is the gun free school zone legislation that could expose our schools for some deranged individual to use as a soft target. A veto is expected for this legislation.

HB 696 the Elder Abuse legislation is a sticking point for our Governor. What this legislation would do is create backdoor Red Flag rules. Elder abuse legislation language is very wide and broad in its scope of what constitutes abuse. If you have an elderly parent or you are the guardian of someone, you are subject to this legislation. Visiting nurses, anti-gun doctors, anti-gun medical technicians, or local law enforcement could bring charges of abuse because you have firearms in a

home with older people living there. Governor Sununu has had great pressure from the anti-gun crowd to sign this legislation. Unfortunately, the firearms confiscation aspect is just a small part of this bill. The Governor has rejected any Red Flag legislation. The problem is the firearm provisos were added to the Elder Care bill.

As this article goes to print, Governor Sununu has not yet vetoed these four bills that passed the House and Senate on party line votes.

If you value your right to own a firearm, please call the Governor at 603-271-2121 and urge him to veto all four of these bills.

If any of these bills become law, we will need to take a hard look at the people that voted for them.

2nd Place - Country Pond Fish & Game Club, with 16.5 points .

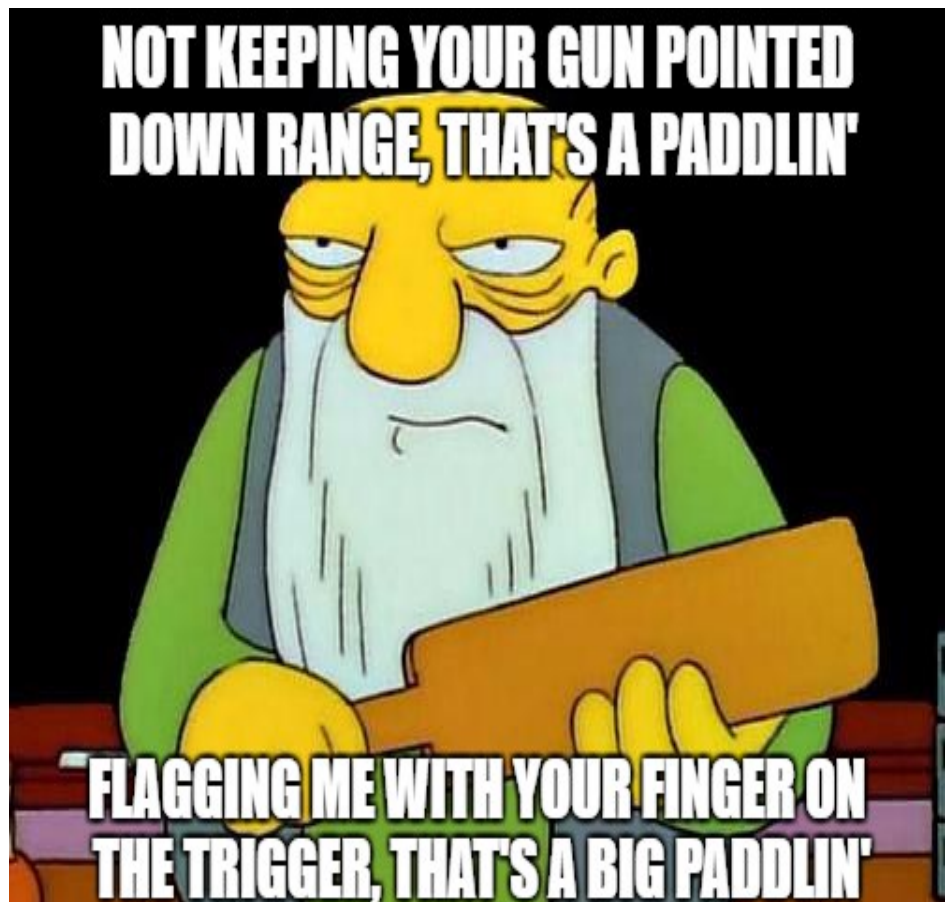
3rd Place - Hampton Rod & Gun Club, with 14 Points.

We concluded with an Awards Banquet at Country Pond Fish & Game club. A good time was had by all.



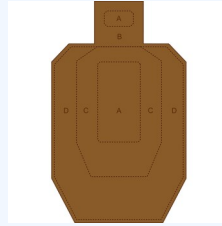

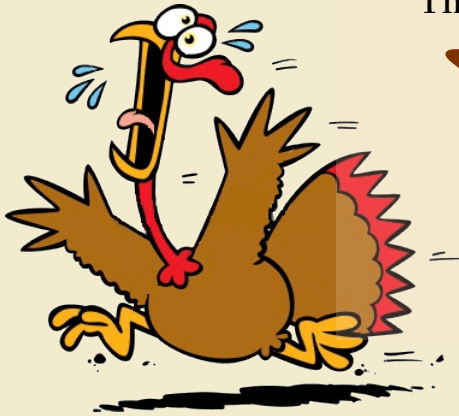

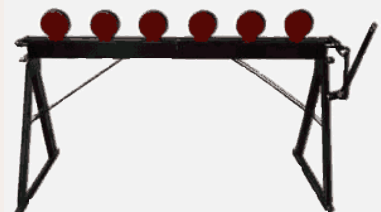
